## Questions for further application of God's Word:

#### **GO DEEPER**

Read 2 Timothy 4:1–5. How serious is Paul's command in 4:2 to "Preach the Word"? How is the seriousness of that command heightened by 4:1? What are some ways that church members demonstrate their commitment to Biblical preaching?

What does Paul mean by "itching ears" in verse 3? How do people accumulate teachers for themselves to suit their own passions? What are some evidences of that in our day? What's the difference between eartickling and sound/healthy teaching?

#### **GET PERSONAL**

Why does Paul tell Timothy to "do the work of an evangelist" (4:5)? How does a preacher/pastor do the work of an evangelist? Is everyone called to the work of evangelism? Are some people uniquely gifted in that area? What are some ways that God might want you to share your faith with another person?

What does it mean to "be ready in season and out of season" (4:2)? How does a member of the church (who doesn't have a preaching role) apply and live out this command? What about the other commands in 4:2 (i.e. reprove, rebuke, exhort)?

### **PUT IT INTO PRACTICE**

Make it a practice on your Sunday morning drive to church to pray 2 Timothy 4:1–5 over your pastor and others in your community. How can you regularly encourage your pastors and elders to continue faithfully preaching the Word?

#### **ADVANCED QUESTION**

When Paul mentions "the Word" in 2 Timothy 4:2, is he referring to the Scriptures or to the Gospel? Is the word "Word" (or "Word of Truth") sometimes used to refer to the gospel message? What about John 1:1, "In the Beginning was the Word?" What are some of the different ways that "Word" (Greek  $\lambda$ óyoς) is used in the Bible?
