## Questions for Further Application of God's Word

### GO DEEPER

Nebuchadnezzar spent years learning about God before finally submitting to Him. What is the difference between recognizing who God is and submitting to Him as Lord?

### GET PERSONAL

Where are you tempted to say, "Look what I have built", rather than, "Look what God has done." Or what are some palaces of pride that God may be revealing in your life?

Nebuchadnezzar was given a year to repent. What does that teach us of God's character? How much more time can you afford to neglect repenting in the areas God brings conviction to in your life.

### PUT IT INTO PRACTICE

What circumstances in your life are hardest for you to trust that The Most High is ruling over them right now?

Daniel pleaded with Nebuchadnezzar to repent even though Nebuchadnezzar had conquered Daniel's homeland. Who in your life is difficult to love, pray for, or share truth with?

### ADVANCED QUESTION

Was Nebuchadnezzar converted, or was he simply humbled? What evidence from the first 4 chapters supports your answer?
