Questions for further application of God’s Word:

GO DEEPER

What is the biblical definition of “holy”? Read **Exodus 30:22–33**. What does that passage about the anointing oil tell you about God’s view of holiness?

How did God’s wisdom preserve Daniel throughout his life? How did wisdom help him during his encounter with Belshazzar?

Read the prophecies of Babylon’s downfall in **Isaiah 13:1-22; Isaiah 21:1–10; Jeremiah 50, 51**. How did God fulfill his promise to judge this Gentile kingdom?

GET PERSONAL

Read **Revelation 1:5-6**. What does this passage tell you about *your* holiness? What does it mean for a new covenant Christian to be a “king and priest” to God?

Read **James 1:5**. What does the Bible say about how we acquire wisdom? How would you rate your “godly wisdom”? Is it greater than your “earthly wisdom”?

Read **1 Peter 2:6**. What is God promising those who trust him? What does it mean to “not be put to shame”? What does that mean for the problems you are currently going through?

PUT IT INTO PRACTICE

Do you consider yourself holy? How does a holy person carry him/herself in this modern day and age? What things must they abstain from? What things must they embrace? What in your life would change if you embraced your identity as a holy child of God?

Think about a situation in your life. What does God’s wisdom say about it? (Consider seeking godly counsel if you are not sure.) In what ways can you apply godly, biblical wisdom to that situation?

Despite what is going on in the world, God has the final say. What is he saying about your life, right now? In what areas do you need to trust his Word over what your feelings, the world, or the enemy are telling you? Do you believe God’s plans for your life will win out over the enemy’s schemes?
