Questions for further application of God's Word:

GO DEEPER

Read Galatians 3:10–14. How did Jesus reverse the curse of sin? Are we still under a curse? If so, why? Can we overcome our "cursed" state by good works? Can we overcome it by faith?

Read Galatians 3:15–18. Sequentially which came first, the promise to Abraham or the Law of Moses? Why is that important to Paul's argument in 3:15–18? Why does Paul keep referencing Abraham in his arguments?

GET PERSONAL

According to Galatians 3:10–18, what has Christ done to provide salvation for you? Have you contemplated the depth of Christ's sacrifice (humiliation!) on your behalf before? How should these theological truths impact our daily lives? How should they impact our worship throughout the week? What about our worship on Sundays at church?

PUT IT INTO PRACTICE

Define the theological term "substitutionary atonement" in your own words. Is this a core Christian doctrine? Can we get saved apart from Christ's atonement? See the following essay by Thomas Schreiner to help you with these questions:
