Questions for further application of God’s Word:

GO DEEPER

How does the concept of a mediator influence our understanding of the relationship between God and humanity? What implications does the idea of a mediator have for our understanding of God’s covenant?

In what way does faith in Christ fulfill or transcend the law? What does it mean to be a “Son” of God through faith, as stated in Galatians 3:26? How does this identity impact the believer’s relationship with God and with one another?

How does Paul’s understanding of the Law as a temporary measure inform our current understanding of moral and ethical directives within Christianity?

GET PERSONAL

How does Paul’s assertion that there is neither Jew nor Greek, neither slave nor free, nor male and female challenge societal norms? What does this radical equality in Christ imply for the early church and contemporary believers?

In what areas of our spiritual lives do we rely on rules or checklists rather than faith and grace?

In what specific areas of my life do I struggle to accept my identity as a son of God, and how can I remind myself of this truth daily?

PUT IT INTO PRACTICE

In what ways can we actively embody our identity as sons of God and heirs of the promise, particularly in how we treat others within our community?

ADVANCED QUESTION

How does Christ’s fulfillment of the Law differ from the idea of abolishing it, and what does this mean for believers regarding their relationship to the law and God?
