Questions for further application of God's Word:

GO DEEPER

What is notable about Paul's tone in Galatians 3:1-6? Does it seem inappropriate? What conclusions can we come to regarding using such a tone?

Paul isn't the only one who uses the term “foolish” to describe someone. Read Luke 24:13-27. What are the appropriate situations to describe someone as foolish?

Paul uses the example of Abraham to illustrate that righteousness is through faith. Read Romans 4:13-25. How can we learn from Abraham's faith to strengthen our faith?

GET PERSONAL

Paul draws on the experience of the Galatians to make the argument that salvation and sanctification are by “hearing with faith” and not according to adherence to the law or circumcision. How does your personal experience of coming to a saving faith in Jesus affirm that we are not saved through good works?

How has God used your personal experiences to confirm both his love for you and theological truth?

PUT IT INTO PRACTICE

How do you think the Galatians responded to Paul's letter? How would you have responded? How can we be teachable to strong correction like Paul uses in these verses?
