Questions for Further Application of God's Word

GO DEEPER

Read Galatians 6:7-8. How does the principle of sowing and reaping apply to both positive and negative actions in our lives? Reflect on Galatians 6:9. What does it mean to "not grow weary of doing good," and how can we apply this in our daily walk with Christ?

GET PERSONAL

Can you recall a time when you sowed good seeds in your life or someone else's life and saw the positive outcomes? How did that experience impact your faith? Have you ever struggled with the concept of sowing to the flesh versus sowing to the Spirit? How did you overcome this struggle, and what did you learn from it?

PUT IT INTO PRACTICE

Think about the different ways you can honor your spiritual teachers, as mentioned in the message. What specific actions can you take this week to show appreciation and support for them? Consider the idea of "never giving up" in your spiritual journey. What are some practical steps you can take to persevere in your faith and service, even when you feel weary?

ADVANCED QUESTION
