## Questions for further application of God's Word:

#### **GO DEEPER**

How can you take your salvation story to the next level? The once-blind man steadily grew in his understanding of God and of Jesus as Messiah. How can you add scriptural truth and doctrinal understanding to your personal testimony to more effectively point people to Jesus?

## **GET PERSONAL**

Have you faced opposition to your witness for Christ? The man born blind was questioned by his friends, not supported by his parents, and cast out of the synagogue by the Pharisees, but despite adversity, he still placed his faith in Jesus. What impact did the man's healing from blindness have on his decision to stand strong for Christ? If we better understood the magnitude of God's blessings in our lives, do you think we might be more willing to stand up for Jesus?

### **PUT IT INTO PRACTICE**

Reflect on what you learned of Christ before you came to faith. Looking back, do you see how the Lord used people, truth, and circumstances to lead you to a saving belief in Christ? How can you help "sow the seed" of faith and God's word in the lives of others that the Holy Spirit can use to move them toward trusting Jesus?

### ADVANCED QUESTIONS FOR DEEPER STUDY

How essential is worship to a Christian? How does God see the importance of worship? How important is it to the spiritual life and health of a believer? Does worship contribute to our growth toward spiritual maturity? Read and consider Romans 12.1-2 (ESV). The Greek word rendered "worship" means an act of service toward God that declares His nature and attributes. True worship is a uniquely Christian experience that involves both the heart and mind of a believer. How can we seek to worship God more completely with our whole hearts?
