Questions for further application of God’s Word:

GO DEEPER

Think over Paul’s final passage in the letter to Titus (3:12-15). How do these verses connect to his overall message to Titus? When considering our entire series, how does Paul’s last remarks bring his instructions to Titus together as a whole? What is God saying to Titus—and to us—in this short, but impactful letter?

GET PERSONAL

While much of Titus is a message directed at leaders, this final passage is applicable to the entire Church. How are you serving your local church? Do you have something good to leave behind, for your brothers and sisters who will come after you? Are you doing something to encourage and equip your pastors, elders, deacons, ministry leaders? How has the body of Christ improved your life? Have you grow in love toward your spiritual family? If that love is lacking, how can you increase the time you spend with your brothers and sisters in Christ?

PUT IT INTO PRACTICE

Do you feel the call to step up and lead in your local church? Has the Lord been speaking to you about serving in a ministry, taking over a leadership role in one, or even becoming a deacon or elder? As seasons change in your life can you be confident that what you’ve done as a follower of Christ can be handed off to the person who will take your place? Perhaps you have never stepped up to serve the Lord in your local church. What ways can you begin to equip your fellow workers and build closer relationships with those in your congregation?
