3. What is the maximum **capacity**, and the comfortable capacity?
4. What are your décor and styling **restrictions**?
5. Are there any hidden or additional **costs**?
6. What is included in the **hire** price?
7. What are the **bar** options and pricing?
8. What **time** does the celebration need to finish?
9. Are **live bands** permitted, and what are the sound restrictions?
10. Do you have a recommended **suppliers** list?
11. What is your **wet-weather** plan?
12. How is the venue laid out for **guest flow**?
13. What are the **catering** options, how are **dietary** requirements managed?
14. Are there noise, timing, or logistical constraints for **suppliers**?
15. What **accommodation** is available on-site or nearby?
16. What **parking** options are available for guests and suppliers?
17. Are the ceremony and reception spaces **accessible**?
18. What **décor** or styling items does the venue already provide?
19. What **support** will we receive from the venue team?
20. How do **payment** schedules, cancellation terms, booking processes work?
