


# SADDLE UP CAMP

Campers entering grades 4th-9th



## Saddle up your horses!

Giddy up to our Saddle Up homestead! Saddle Up offers campers many opportunities to expand their knowledge of horses while growing in faith alongside their fellow campers. All Saddle Up programming teaches Biblical truth through God's gift of horses. In addition, campers can look forward to the pool, chapels, Bible studies, food cooked over the fire, and sleeping in bunk wagons for the week. YeeHaw!



## Level 1



### No experience necessary!

Level 1 campers learn basic horsemanship in the arena. Enjoy activities that improve your riding abilities, such as balance and control of your horse. You'll be riding with confidence in no time! Our Saddle Up staff will assist each camper one-on-one in their riding.

## Level 2

### Prior horse experience needed: Level 1 completed or more than 8 hours of lessons/ 4-H horse club completed.

Level 2 campers continue horsemanship lessons in the arena with additional activities, and they also venture out on a short trail ride. You will also learn some basic horse anatomy! Each pair of campers will have a wrangler to assist them with their riding.

## Level 3

### Prior horse experience needed: Level 2 completed or more than one year of lessons/ 4-H horse club completed.

Level 3 campers grow by deepening their understanding of riding equipment, horse care and management, and more advanced horsemanship. Horse experience is required as this week involves trail riding and taking more responsibility for your horse.

## Level 4

### Prior horse experience needed: Level 3 completed or more than two years of lessons/ 4-H horse club completed.

Level 4 campers will practice advanced horsemanship in a unique setting as they explore [new ground at Inspiration Hills](#) and gain more trail riding experience. Campers will be able to do tent camping as they bid farewell to their Saddle Up experience for one last Yee-Haw!

## Hybrid

### Prior horse experience needed: Level 2 completed or more than 8 hours of lessons/ 4-H horse club completed.

Hybrid campers will advance their trail-riding and horse management skills during this 3-day, 2-night camp. Unique to the hybrid level is a beautiful sunrise and sunset trail ride through the hills! Campers will fit a full week's worth of riding into just three unforgettable days.



# C.H.I.P.S.

Campers entering grades 10th-12th



## Christian Hearts in Powerful Service

C.H.I.P.S. is a leadership program where campers will stay at camp for two weeks instead of one. The first week is similar to other camps, with the addition of lessons and exercises in leadership. From team building to selflessly serving others, campers will learn and practice how to be effective leaders for Christ. C.H.I.P.S. campers will have an opportunity to experience and visit other camp programs (Wilderness, Lodge, and Day Camp) and get to see how camp works behind the scenes. In the second week, C.H.I.P.S. have the opportunity to co-lead a bunk group alongside a counselor!

Due to the nature of this program, each C.H.I.P.S. camper will go through an interview process to determine if C.H.I.P.S. is the right camp for your camper. When registering, your camper will be placed on a waitlist until the interview. After the interview process, the program team will decide on the acceptance of the camper into the program. You will not be charged until a decision is made.

## WAYS TO REGISTER

## REGISTRATIONS MUSTS

- A minimum payment of \$75 is required for each camper to register and hold their spot, and it is non-refundable.
- Please indicate only ONE bunkmate.

## SCHOLARSHIPS

Many churches help with a scholarship for your camper. Please indicate the amount of the church scholarship on the registration form. If you do not know the correct amount the church is paying, please contact your church. Scholarship amounts do not include canteen money or other fees unless your church indicates otherwise.

Inspiration Hills offers scholarships for campers who need financial assistance. Scholarships must be applied for by using the Scholarship Application Form. Scholarships will be granted from 10-80% of the remaining balance after any other scholarships, and will not be accepted after April 15. Please complete the Scholarship Application Form and submit it within 3 days of your online registration. Forms can be found online at [inspirationhills.org](http://inspirationhills.org) under the Summer Camp tab. Please send it in via mail or email.

## PAYMENT

Inspiration Hills accepts Visa, MasterCard, Discover, AMEX, Checks, and Cash. All accounts must be paid in full by May 15.



## **CONFIRMATION**

After registering online, you will receive an email confirming the camp and the registered dates. Parents are responsible for ensuring their camper(s) are registered for the correct date and camp.

## **CANCELLATION POLICY**

The \$75 minimum registration fee, non-refundable, will hold your camper's spot until May 15; payment is due in full thereafter. After May 15, each registered camper who cancels will be charged a \$125 administration fee, and only partial refunds will be issued. If your child is sick within 2 weeks of camp or during camp, a partial refund will be issued, minus the \$125 administration fee. If Inspiration Hills is required to cancel any camp, full refunds will be given.

## **WHAT TO BRING**

"What to Bring" forms can be found online at [inspirationhills.org](http://inspirationhills.org) on each Camp Option's webpage. This form includes the registration time/date and the final chapel details for each camp.

## **GENDER/SEX**

Inspiration Hills assigns campers who attend overnight camps into bunk groups based on biological sex at birth and will refer to them by their given name as stated on their registration. For further information, please refer to the Statement of Faith on the Inspiration Hills website.

## **DRESS CODE**

Modest clothes without offensive wording and modest swimsuits (one-piece for girls and swimming trunks for boys) are required. Please refrain from bringing spandex shorts, crop tops, or other revealing clothing.

## CANTEEN MONEY

Snacks and Souvenirs money can now be added online! We suggest \$10-\$25 for week-long camps and \$8-\$15 for 3-day camps. Unspent money for each camper will be used for Camper Scholarships! Canteen Money will be listed for the camper on your online registration under the camper's name.

## CAMPER MAIL

Letters, postcards, and emails are encouraged for campers! You may send them in the mail or drop them off at the registration table.

- Place the name of the camper, the camp, and the day of the week you would like the camper to receive it on the envelope.
- NEW: You can now send your camper mail through our website! Go to [inspirationhills.org](http://inspirationhills.org) and look under the summer camp tab!

## PHONE CALLS

We discourage phone calls during the camper's time at Inspiration Hills, as it may encourage homesickness. If mom or dad needs to be called, we will contact you. If you have any emergencies, please call the camp office at 712-986-5193.

## PHONES

Campers are not permitted to possess a cell phone or any other electronic devices for any reason at camp. Any camper who brings a cellphone/device will have their cellphone or device confiscated and kept in a secure location until the last day of camp.

## MEDICATIONS

All medication for campers 18 and under, whether prescription or non-prescription, must be turned in to the camp nurse at registration. Please clearly write down the camper's name, the medication name, dosage, and the frequency of administration. Medications will be distributed under the supervision of the camp nurse as instructed by the parent or physician.

## REGISTRATION DAY

- 2 pm is the start time for registration day (Excludes Day Camp & camps starting on Wednesday).
- Please refer to the "What to Bring" form for your camp's registration day/time and bus stops (if applicable).
- For more details about your camp, see your "What to Bring" form.

## **FINAL CHAPEL/PICK-UP DAY**

- Family is invited and encouraged to attend the Final Chapel Service and meal at noon.
- Please refer to your campers “What to Bring” form for more detailed information about pick-up times.
- The meal is served at noon with the Final Chapel Service to follow on Friday for all camps, except camps ending on Wednesday, where the final chapel starts at 11 am.
- Final chapel runs for approximately 30-45 minutes.

## **DISCLOSURE & CONFIDENTIALITY**

If a camper discloses any abuse, self-harm, suicidal thoughts, or thoughts of harming others, whether past or current, it will be reported to the proper channels (Guardian, authorities, etc).

## **CAMPERS LEAVING CAMPUS**

Campers leaving campus for events, practices, recitals, etc., are permitted to leave once (1) during their registered week of camp. If they must leave camp again, their camp week will end. In the case of family/personal emergencies, Inspiration Hills will make accommodations for parents/guardians. All comings and goings of campers, unless in an emergency, must be communicated to and approved by the Office Manager and/or Program Directors before the first day of camp.

## **BEHAVIORAL CONDUCT:**

Campers who engage in behavior that endangers the physical, mental, or spiritual well-being of others are subject to disciplinary action. This may include, but is not limited to, sitting out of an activity, spending time in the Program Director’s office, or being sent home. Program Director will contact parents/guardians if situations escalate, remain unresolved, or are deemed necessary.
