Diocese of St. Augustine
Begin National Shrine of Our Lady of La Leche, St. Augustine
Continue to Cathedral Basilica of St. Augustine

DAY 2 MONDAY, MAY 25
Diocese of St. Augustine to Diocese of Savannah
Begin Christ the King Catholic Church, Jacksonville
Continue to St. Michael Catholic Church, Fernandina Beach
Handover *The Eucharistic procession will cross the St. Marys' River into Georgia, where it will be entrusted to the Diocese of Savannah —continuing the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage in faith-filled unity.*
