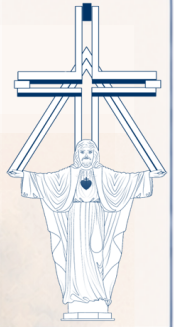

The novena concludes with the consecration of the United States to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

We Hold These Truths

As the United States of America commemorates the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence in 2026, the USCCB joins this celebration by lifting up the contributions of Catholics and the impact of our faith on the history of this country. In a historic moment, the U.S. bishops will consecrate the United States to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on **June 11, 2026**, and invite all parishes to join in this consecration.

**The devotion to the Sacred Heart is not about venerating a physical organ, but about entering into a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ. The Sacred Heart embodies Jesus' human and divine heart, allowing for us to better understand His infinite and perfect love for humanity. This same heart of Jesus is still active in our lives through the working of the Holy Spirit. In the silence of our own hearts, we can find the presence of Christ, which is the heart of the world. We are called to respond to this love by placing our trust in the "infinite mercy of a God who loves us unconditionally and has already given us everything in the cross of Jesus Christ"*

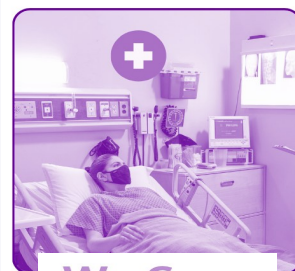
REMINDER: Pastoral Care at Holy Faith

Outreach Ministry to the Sick

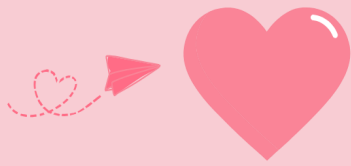

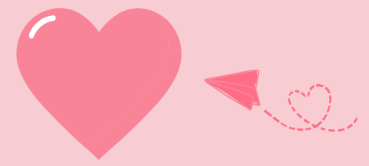

My heart cannot take saying goodbye to any of you. So, I will say that I will see you again soon. You will always be in my prayers. Please keep me in yours.

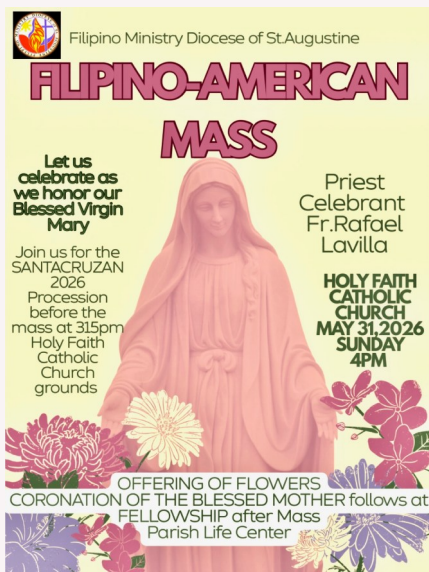

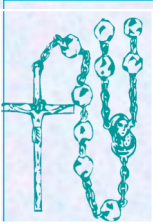
