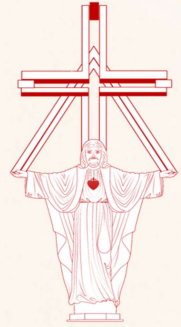

This Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus draws its daily devotions from the *Litany of the Sacred Heart*.

Each day reflects on the wisdom of saints and pontiffs on the Sacred Heart and offers opportunities for prayer and action, framed by Pope Francis' encyclical *Dilexisti Nos* (He Loved Us) and Pope Leo XIV's apostolic exhortation *Dilexisti Te* (I Have Loved You).

The novena concludes with the consecration of the United States to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

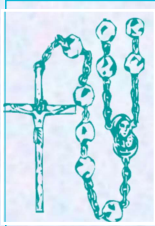
