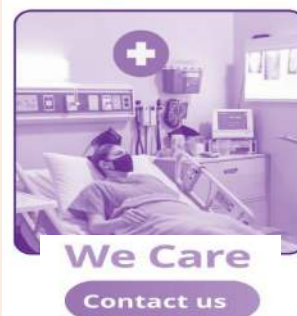

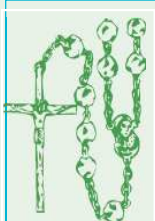

Stewardship is a Way of Life

The theme of today's readings is God's great love for His people. In the Book of Exodus, God calls Moses to remind the ancient Israelites of the blessings He bestows on those who keep His covenant. St. Paul, in his Letter to the Romans, describes God's love in how we are reconciled to Him through the death of His son, Jesus Christ. And in St. Matthew's Gospel, Jesus sends the Apostles out to the people of Israel to Proclaim the Kingdom of Heaven. Even that long ago, Jesus was concerned there was a shortage of messengers to carry the Good News when He said: The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few.
