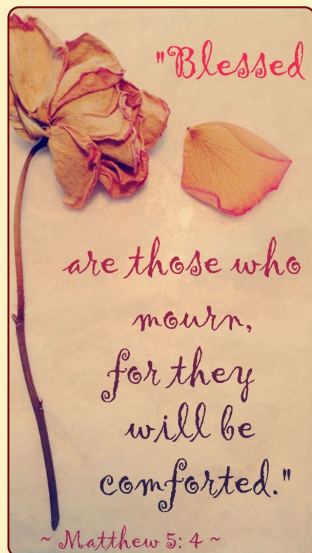

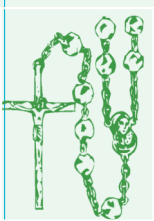


*If you are not currently a registered parishioner of Holy Faith, we invite you to join our church family. We welcome all people of faith, even if not Catholic, to be part of our church family.*

*Sacrifice links today's Scripture readings. In the Second Book of Kings, the prophet Elisha sacrifices time to visit the woman of influence and her husband. Because of his kindness, they provide him with hospitality. In turn, he promises them a son. St. Paul, in his Letter to the Romans, acknowledges Christ's sacrifice for sin: He died to sin once and for all.
