The Year of Saint Francis

Holy Faith Parish, among others, has been designated a sacred place within the Diocese of St. Augustine because of our connection to the Franciscan family and their spiritual importance within our Diocese.

Plenary Indulgence

In making a pilgrimage or pious visit to this sacred place, the faithful may gain the Plenary Indulgence by fulfilling the following conditions:

- Reception of Holy Communion (at least within 7 days before or after the visit).
- A sincere detachment from sin, including making a Sacramental Confession (at least within 7 days before or after the visit).
- Prayer for the intentions of our Holy Father Pope Leo.
- Spend at least a reasonable period of time in pious meditation and raise prayers to God so that, following the example of Saint Francis, feelings of Christian charity towards their neighbors and authentic vows of harmony and peace among peoples may spring forth in their hearts, concluding with the Our Father, the Creed and invocations to the Blessed Virgin Mary, Saint Francis of Assisi, Saint Clare and all the Saints of the Franciscan Family.



The elderly, the sick and those who take care of them, and all those who are unable to leave their homes for serious reasons may also obtain a Plenary Indulgence, provided they detach themselves from any sin and intend to fulfil the three usual conditions as soon as possible, if they unite themselves spiritually to the jubilee celebrations of the Year of Saint Francis, offering to the Merciful God their prayers, the pains or sufferings of their lives.

Notes about Sacramental Preparation

- ♦ First Reconciliation and First Communion prep begins with attendance in First Grade and is a 2-year program.
- ♦ Confirmation preparation begins with attendance in 8th grade and is also a 2-year program.
- ♦ Catholic, private or homeschooled children who have not received the First Sacraments (grade 2 and above) must register for prep classes held on specific Sundays.
- ♦ Catholic, private or homeschooled children who have not received Confirmation (grades 9 and above) must register for prep classes held on specific Sundays.
- ♦ All youth, including Catholic, private or homeschool students can register for Catholic Youth Ministry (CYM) on this same form (grades 8th thru 12th). The youth group meets on selected Sundays from 4pm to 5:30pm and offers the youth a safe place to grow and share in their faith with their peers, and includes service projects to aid in earning required service hours.

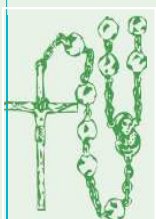


If you are not currently a registered parishioner of Holy Faith, we invite you to join our church family. We welcome all people of faith, even if not Catholic, to be part of our church family.

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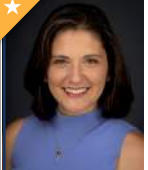
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
