Morning Drop Off Procedure K-8th Grade

Enter through the large (**Upper**) lot off of Elizabeth Avenue. Circle behind the parish offices and rectory to the student drop-off point. The children will enter the school through the main entrance. (Door A) Exit onto Elizabeth Avenue.

Dismissal Procedure

PreK-3rd Grade

If you have a student in these grades, please park in the small (Lower) lot off Millman Drive. Back into a parking spot or pull into the middle row facing the soccer field. If the lot has already closed, please park on Millman and walk up the school steps to get your child. Children WILL not be released to Millman Rd for safety.

All students, PreK-3, will be released through this lot. If your child has older siblings in grades 4-8, have the older children walk down to the bottom lot for pick-up.

PreK parents should walk up to the middle lot to meet their children and accompany them to their car.

Children **will not** be allowed to walk down the steps until a teacher has closed the lot at Millman Drive. When the lot is closed, K-3 children will then walk down to their parents. Teachers will release vehicles after all children have descended the steps and are in cars. Please **do not** leave the parking lot until the teacher has dismissed your row.

4th-8th Grade

If a student has a PreK-3rd grade sibling, they should walk down the steps to the lower lot for dismissal.

All other students, 4th-8th, will be released through the large (Upper) lot off Elizabeth Avenue. Do not pick up your child from the main door area. Please back into a parking spot and remain in your vehicle. If the lot is closed, you must park on Elizabeth Avenue and walk over to pick up your child from the upper lot. Please note, if you park on the west side of Elizabeth, you must accompany your child across the street or he/she will cross over at Darst Rd with a teacher.

Walkers

Walkers will meet under the tree at the entrance of the upper lot. A teacher will walk students across Darst Road and/ or Elizabeth. Students are not allowed to cross these streets unaccompanied. Your children's safety is our top priority during these time
