KEY ARGUMENTS AGAINST THE ASSISTED DYING BILL

- Risk to Vulnerable People: Legalizing assisted suicide could expose the elderly, disabled, and those under financial or emotional pressure to coercion or abuse.
- Safeguards Are Insufficient: Even with proposed amendments, there is no guarantee that safeguards will prevent mistakes or exploitation.
- Impact on Palliative Care: Evidence from other countries shows that assisted suicide laws often lead to reduced investment in palliative care services.
- Slippery Slope: Once legalized for terminal illness, pressure grows to extend eligibility to chronic conditions or mental health issues. (like Canada, Belgium, Ohio)
- Moral and Ethical Concerns: The Bill undermines the principle that every life has inherent dignity and worth, regardless of illness or disability.
