5.00pm Thanksgiving Liturgy for the Pilgrimage, to which all are welcome.

6.30pm Mass as usual.

7.30pm Ceilidh to welcome the Pilgrimage of Hope. All are warmly invited to a celebration Ceilidh in Cathedral Hall to welcome the Jubilee pilgrims. Mancunian Irish folk trio 'Ride On' provide the music.
