### **Advent or the Coming of Christ**

Advent is a season observed in most Christian denominations as a time of expectant waiting and preparation for both the celebration of the Nativity of Christ at Christmas and the return of Christ at the Second Coming. Advent is the beginning of the liturgical year in Western Christianity. The season of Advent in the Christian calendar anticipates the "coming of Christ" from three different perspectives: the physical nativity in Bethlehem, the reception of Christ in the heart of the believer, and the eschatological Second Coming. **Practices** associated with Advent include Advent calendars, lighting of the Advent wreath, praying an Advent daily devotional, erecting a Christmas tree as well as other ways of preparing for Christmas, such as setting up Christmas decorations.
