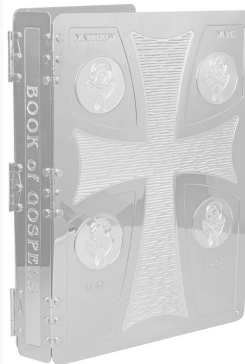

## The Holy Name of Jesus

In the commandments given to Mose on Mount Sinai, and handed down to us, we are told to honor the name of God. We celebrate the feast of Jesus' holy name in order to foster a deep love for His name. If we pray the name of Jesus continually in this life, then it will be His name that we pronounce when we meet our Savior face to face.
