Month of Our Lady's Assumption

August, dedicated to the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, invites us to lift our hearts toward the heavenly life to which Mary has already been taken. In this spirit, our parish continues to grow through four simple yet grace-filled "clubs," each reflecting a dimension of Gospel living.



Breakfast Club

Every third Sunday at Our Lady of Perpetual Help, parishioners gather to share breakfast in a spirit of apostolic fellowship. This practice echoes the early Church:

"They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers." — Acts 2:42
Coming together, being together, and sharing together strengthens our communion in Christ.



Coffee Club

Each Thursday after the 7:30 AM Holy Mass, some of us meet at McDonald's for coffee. This simple gathering becomes a moment of unity and encouragement.

Prayer Club

This group holds the needs of others before God, imitating Mary's intercessory heart.

A listening ear is a ministry. This new format offers a gentle space for anyone who needs to speak and be heard.
