



## Pastors Corner

Dear family,

“A Season of Returning to the Lord”

March leads us deeper into the grace of Lent, a time when the Church gently invites us to slow down, reflect, and return to God with renewed trust. As the earth begins to awaken from winter, our hearts too are called to awaken to the presence of Christ who walks with us toward the joy of Easter. The Lord speaks to us with tenderness: “Return to Me with all your heart.” (Joel 2:12)

A small story helps illuminate this season. A water-bearer carried two clay pots each day—one perfect, the other cracked. The cracked pot felt ashamed because it lost water along the path. One day it apologized, saying, “I fail you every day.” The water-bearer smiled and pointed to the flowers blooming along one side of the road. “I planted seeds there,” he said. “You watered them without knowing. Because of your crack, beauty has grown.”

Lent reminds us that God works through our weaknesses. What we see as flaws, God can transform into grace. St. Paul echoes this truth: “My grace is sufficient for you, for My power is made perfect in weakness.” (2 Corinthians 12:9)

This month, we are invited to deepen our prayer, simplify our lives through fasting, and open our hearts in generosity. These practices do not burden us—they free us. They help us see that God is already at work, even in the cracked places of our lives.

May this holy season draw us closer to Christ and prepare our hearts for Easter’s new life.
