Dear Family.

September invites us to begin again with renewed faith. As the season changes, the Church directs our attention to the ****Word of God****, the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Holy Cross, and the saints who witnessed courageously to Christ.

On ****8 September****, we celebrate the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Mary is called “the hope of the entire world and the dawn of salvation,” because through her humble obedience, she became the Mother of the Savior. On ****14 September****, we celebrate the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, remembering that Christ transformed the instrument of suffering into the sign of redemption. The following day, ****15 September****, we honor Our Lady of Sorrows, who stood faithfully beside her Son at the Cross.

September is therefore a special opportunity to place our families, struggles, and hopes in God’s hands. Mary teaches us to listen to God’s Word, remain faithful in suffering, and serve others with humility.

A child once asked his mother why she prayed every night for a family member who had stopped attending church. The mother replied, “Because love does not stop praying.”

Years passed, and the family member gradually returned to faith. Later he said, “I came back because I never forgot that someone was praying for me.”

This story reminds us of Saint Monica, whose prayers and tears helped lead her son Augustine back to Christ. Her example teaches us that patient prayer can become a hidden instrument of God’s grace.
