

DIRECT CREMATION

\$1,500 - \$16,500

Our package charges for direct cremation include basic services of funeral director and staff, the local (within 15 miles) transfer of deceased to the funeral home, the basic sheltering of the deceased, the obtaining of necessary permits and authorizations, local transportation to the crematory, sanitary care, and preparation of deceased for identification. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to cremation, or any sheltering for days on which no post-death activities occur. It does NOT include the actual cost of the cremation process, which is a crematory charge, nor any other cash disbursements, or anything not expressly stated as being provided.

- ♦ *If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are cardboard.*

***Direct Cremation Packages must be paid for in advance, or the fee for standard itemized prices will apply**

1. Direct cremation with container provided by purchaser **\$1,500**
2. Direct cremation with included alternative container **\$1,500**
3. Direct cremation with 15 minute private identification of sanitized remains within our funeral home **\$1,850**

RECEIVING DECEASED FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME: \$3,600

This package charge includes receiving the deceased from the other funeral home, local transportation from Newark Airport or other source (within 15 miles), the basic sheltering of the deceased, basic services of funeral director and staff, the obtaining of necessary permits and authorizations, and local (within 15 miles) transportation to the cemetery or crematory. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to burial or cremation, or any sheltering for days on which no post-death activities occur. Nor does it include the charges of a common carrier, charges from the shipping service or anything not expressly stated as being provided.

FORWARDING DECEASED TO OTHER FUNERAL HOME: \$4,500

This package charge includes local removal (within 15 miles) of deceased to this funeral home, embalming, local transportation to Newark Airport or other destination (within 15 miles), basic services of funeral director and staff, the basic sheltering of deceased, embalming and obtaining necessary permits. It does not include a casket or alternative or shipping container, the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to forwarding the deceased, or any sheltering for days on which no post-death activities occur, nor does it include charges of a common carrier, or anything not expressly stated as being provided. *house calls add an extra \$150

IMMEDIATE BURIAL

\$3,650 - \$16,500

Our package charges for immediate burial include basic services of funeral director and staff, the local (within 15 miles) transfer of deceased to the funeral home, the basic sheltering of the deceased, the obtaining of necessary permits and authorizations, and local transportation to the cemetery, sanitary care, and preparation of deceased for identification. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to burial, or any sheltering for days on which no post-death activities occur. Nor does it include the actual cost of the grave at the cemetery, or the cemetery's charges for opening and closing of the grave, and required outer burial container or cash disbursements, or anything not expressly stated as being provided.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services. If legal or other requirements means you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but are not limited to:

1. Responding to the initial request for service. **\$2,500**
2. Conducting the arrangement conference.
3. Preparation of biographical and statistical data.
4. Examination of financial settlement options.
5. Preparation and filing of papers, permit, and authorizations.
6. Coordination with those providing other services.
7. Preparation and placement of obituary notices.
8. Retention and care of deceased prior to commencement of post-death activities.

This fee for our basic services will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving deceased)

EMBALMING:

(Includes use of preparation room and sanitary care)

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with a viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. If you choose to have an embalming performed the descendant may be embalmed at a location other than this registered mortuary. No human deceased may remain unburied or uncremated in New Jersey for more than 48 hours unless embalmed or refrigerated (N.J. A.C. 8-9-1.1)

(Includes use of preparation room not including embalming)

1. Refrigeration charge for non-embalmed deceased, per day charge includes any sheltering **\$150**

4. Restoration and other procedures (per hour) **\$175**
5. Adjustment and re-positioning for receiving remains **\$325**
