


01 MAR LOSE A DAY CROSSING THE INTERNATIONAL DATELINE

02 MAR

DAY 1 ARRIVE SYDNEY, AUSTRALIA (D)

G'Day and welcome to Australia! On arrival in Sydney this morning, you will be met by our local representative and transferred to your hotel. Later this evening enjoy a *welcome dinner*.

03 MAR

DAY 2 FULL DAY BLUE MOUNTAIN TOUR (B/L)

Travel to the Blue Mountains. on route stop at the Featherdale wildlife park. View Koalas, kangaroos and wallabies, wombats, fairy penguins and Australian reptiles. The Blue Mountains are a natural wonderland of untamed bush, spectacular rock formations and native wildlife. Enjoy 2 course lunch at the Blue Mountain local restaurant. Experience nature and epic views like never before with an Unlimited Discovery Pass.

04 MAR

DAY 3 SYDNEY CITY SIGHTSEEING TOUR (B/L)

Drive through the historic 'Rocks' area where Australia was first founded. Drive under the famous 'coat hanger', the Sydney Harbour Bridge and view Sydney's famous architectural masterpiece, the Sydney Opera House. Set sail to Michaelmas Cay on the Great Barrier Reef aboard the beautiful sailing catamaran Ocean Spirit. Snorkel or dive in the fringing reef, filled with vibrant marine life, or spend some time observing the seabirds that call this protected sanctuary home.

07 MAR

DAY 6 FULL DAY KURANDA TOUR (B/L)

Kuranda is the aboriginal for 'village in the rainforest', and over the years Kuranda has taken on a distinctive character as a popular visitor destination in its own right. Experience the original Kuranda Scenic Railway, Pamagirri Aboriginal, army Duck Rainforest Tour, Koala & Wildlife Park and return to Cairns by Skyrail Rainforest Cableway.

08 MAR

DAY 7 CAIRNS TO AYERS ROCK (B/D)



After breakfast, you will be collected from your hotel for private coach transfer to the airport. Fly Cairns to Ayers Rock. In the evening experience the Sounds of Silence Dinner.

09 MAR

DAY 8 **AYERS ROCK** (B/D)

Travel to the sunrise viewing area of Uluru (Ayers Rock) and watch the first sunlight of the day creep across the desert plains. take a walking tour of Mutitjulu Waterhole, where you can view Aboriginal rock art. We travel to the Olgas also known in the Aboriginal language as "Kata Tjuta" translated as "many heads". Return to the sunset viewing strip to see the Rock at its most dramatic. Later enjoy the Night at Field of Light Dinner.

10 MAR

DAY 9 **AYERS ROCK TO MELBOURNE** (B)

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to Melbourne.

11 MAR

DAY 10 MELBOURNE SIGHTSEEING AND PHILLIP ISLAND TOUR

(B)

View Captain Cook's Cottage in the beautiful Fitzroy Gardens. Pass by the Botanical Gardens and observe the famous Queen Victorian Markets. Continue along taking in views of the Shrine of Remembrance and St Patrick's Cathedral. depart to Phillip Island. Visit to Moonlit Sanctuary Conservation Park and head to the island (Phillip Island)

And finally, the Penguin Parade. You will sit on the protective platform to see possibly hundreds of little penguins waddling onto the beach.

12 MAR

DAY 11 GREAT OCEAN ROAD (B)

Travel through Lorne and make a stop at Kennett River. Continue on to the seaside resort of Apollo Bay and a leisurely stroll along the beach.

See the Twelve Apostles - huge stone pillars rising from the surf, remnants of London Bridge, a rocky promontory arch carved out by the continual force of the sea, Lock Ard Gorge - site of the dramatic shipwreck the "Loch Ard" over 100 years ago.

13 MAR

DAY 12 DEPART MELBOURNE TO CHRISTCHURCH (B)

After breakfast, check out of your hotel and transfer to the airport for your flight to Christchurch, New Zealand.

14 MAR

DAY 13 AKAROA (B/D)

Experience majestic scenery and stunning wildlife. You'll see the rare, native dolphin – the Hector's or New Zealand Dolphin. There's also the chance to spot the world's smallest penguin, the White Flippered Little Blue Penguin, Fur Seals and other sea birds.



15 MAR

DAY 14 CHRISTCHURCH – TEKAPO - QUEENSTOWN

(B/D)

Depart to Queenstown via Lake Tekapo, Mackenzie Country, Lindis Pass, and Cromwell. In the evening enjoy Skyline Queenstown - Gondola and Dinner.

16 MAR

DAY 15 QUEENSTOWN – MILFORD SOUND - QUEENSTOWN

(B/L)

The cruise takes in the length of Milford Sound, and offers excellent viewing of waterfalls, rainforest, mountains and wildlife.

17 MAR

DAY 16 QUEENSTOWN - ROTORUA

(B)

After breakfast, meet with your driver at hotel lobby and transfer to airport for your domestic flight to Rotorua.

18 MAR

DAY 17 ROTORUA FULL DAY TOUR

(B/L/D)

Explore Rotorua city and its surrounding areas. Highlights include Lake Rotorua, Redwood Forest and Government Gardens.

Experience the Agrodome- Farm Tour and later visit Te Puia with a combo of Guided experience + Indigenous Evening

19 MAR

DAY 18 ROTORUA – WAITOMO - AUCKLAND

See the amazing underground Glow Worm Grotto by boat and walk through the limestone caverns. 250 metres of stunning underground scenery commencing with the impressive Cathedral.
