Annual Report

Due to strong re-enrollment and the admission of new families, the CMS Elementary program is growing again, and our new Adolescent guide worked diligently last winter in preparation for the fall 2025 Adolescent Program launch.

Academic achievement continues to be a hallmark of the CMS experience: all six of the May 2025 graduates were accepted into their first-choice secondary schools: one to John Burroughs School, two to Westminster Academy, and three to the new CMS Adolescent program.

Upper Elementary children as a group scored as well as or better than their independent school peers across all seven subject areas in the spring Comprehensive Testing Program standardized test—in spite of the fact that CMS children do not regularly take tests of any kind prior to the Adolescent Program.

CMS achieved Great Place to Work certification for the third year in a row—the only school in Missouri to have this recognition. CMS is also the only St. Louis area school to be both recognized by Association Montessori Internationale and accredited by the Independent Schools Association of the Central states. These distinctions, alongside an immense culturally diverse and engaged community, make Chesterfield Montessori stand out as a truly unique educational institution that supports families in raising capable children.

As we reflect on the 2024-2025 school year with the Chesterfield Montessori School providing Montessori in Every Moment™, there is a great deal to be proud of.


In fall 2024, we completed the demolition of the non-operational, Olympic sized swimming pool. That space has since been covered with grass, providing the Elementary and Adolescent students another place to explore. Primary children took many nature walks to visit the tadpoles and frogs living in the pond that emerged in one part of the field. Washington University students from the Sam Fox School of Design & Visual Arts created modular wooden obstacle course structures for our students to enjoy, and they are now available for recess. These experiences are giving us a glimpse of what's to come as we seek funding partners to construct the planned NatureScape playground. The Administration will be working with Board members, interested parents and friends of the school to hold third party events to raise funds for the planned project while also increasing awareness of CMS in the community, attracting new mission-aligned families, volunteers and philanthropic partners.

School spirit was evident during the November 2024 Pink Tower Campaign, with 100% participation from the CMS board, staff and families contributing to the campaign. This level of community participation is particularly noteworthy when measured against the 2024-2025 National Association of Independent Schools' "Facts at a Glance," which lists a median parent/guardian participation rate of 66% for member schools' annual giving. The CMS community's commitment speaks volumes about our shared dedication to the school's mission.
