Welcome to the May Club News Update.

The Rowes Bay Management Committee is concerned by the negative feedback regarding the clubs decision to enforce that only food made in a commercial kitchen can be served at events held in the clubhouse. Our club has a food license to provide catering, if we get caught by the council allowing food to be served that has not come from a commercial kitchen we will lose our license, and in turn lose a source of income. The council can do spot checks at their discretion. The club offers catering at reasonable prices and will work within budgets. Any function that is held at the club should be catered by the club, approval for any out sourced catering will need to be given by either Bar Manager Julie White or General Manager Gary Toplis.

Course Update

Grounds Superintendent Jason reports that the 12th green is growing in very well so far & we will be looking at having it in play early in July at this stage. We still have work to do on the surrounds with getting grass on this area but that will be a priority over the next few weeks. A lot of off coloured patches around the course at the moment is from the recent herbicide applications.

This has gone quite well with a fair amount of crows foot being successfully knocked out only minimal areas that will need to have follow up spraying. Weather conditions over the last couple of weeks have been a lot more favourable for getting greens in good condition and they seem to be rolling better at the moment.
