Before I get to my TOP 3, let me quickly review our EQUIP423 Conference and Annual Meeting. We had 34 churches represented with, a total attendance of 461. The breakout sessions were a HUGE success - with folks asking for more! The Inspirational Rally was GREAT with the music from the PVN worship leaders and the message by Sam Greer. In the business session we updated the FCBA Constitution & Bylaws, approved a budget of \$272,804.38 for 2023 and elected officers Chris Hayes, Pastor of Sherwood as Moderator; Mac McCurry, Pastor of Pleasant Valley North as Moderator-Elect; and Jerry Dudley, Pastor of Pisgah, as Clerk. We also heard reports from all the ministry areas and approved the reports from all teams and committees. It was a busy day! We also reaffirmed our mission: ***"encouraging and equipping pastors and people to do the Great Commandment and the Great Commission"*** and our eight priorities of being a ***praying, reaching, discipling, going, caring, growing, training, and giving*** association. The 131st gathering of the FCBA will be Sunday, September 17, 2023 at Pleasant Valley South Baptist Church.

GBC EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE UPDATE



Last month I attended the Georgia Baptist (GB) Executive Committee meeting as the representative of the Floyd County Baptist Association. Here is a quick summary of that gathering:

The Penfield Christian Home had over 200 baptisms last year.

The Cooperative Program (CP) Task Force Report

Prior to 2021 the three Georgia Baptist colleges received 11.5% of all CP gifts that come into GB. In 2022, that percentage has been reduced to 10% because of declining CP giving. Here is how Shorter University will be impacted. In the past few years, Shorter has been receiving \$2.2 million with all of those dollars from GB churches being used for scholarships for GB students. In the proposed GB budget for 2023, Shorter will receive \$1.6 million and the plans for 2024 will reduce it to a little over \$1 million.

Administrative Committee Report

The GB is debt free. The 2020-21 has been completed and satisfactory. The financial health of GB has improved.

Recommendation on GB colleges funding to be reduced to 10% of CP receipts annually. In 3 years all schools will receive an equal amounts of funding.

A task force was appointed to review the constitution and bylaws of GB.

Thomas Hammond Report

The 200 year anniversary of GB will be celebrated on November 13-16 at the annual meeting at Warren Baptist Church in Augusta.

There will be a special IMB/NAMB Commissioning Service on Sunday night.

BCM & Fourstone partnering together. This is a \$110 million partnership with Fourstone for 4 new BCM buildings. Because of the DOJ investigation of the SBC Executive Committee, Fourstone has pushed the pause button.

David Melber presented the new budget \$32 million for CP target for 2023 (see website for details).

The Sugarloaf Sale—Due to many restrictions placed on this sale by Gwinnett County Commission, our main client has walked away. At the present time, we are seeking a lease client (commercial real estate appraisals are down). The bids received were from \$11 to \$35 million. Lease client we are seeking would be a 3-5 year agreement.

Mission Georgia Report (Beth Ann Williams)

There are Afghan refugees staying in extended stay motels in Georgia. Over 40 churches mobilized to provide resources and share the gospel to these people. 300 Ukraine refugees were welcomed and packets were given as well as dental services from our mobile dental clinic.

GB are building 2 tiny homes for people rescued from human trafficking.

A total of \$345,000 has been given to churches on front lines for the ministry-foster care and adoptions.

Over 200 churches committed to teach 3rd graders how to read through Read Georgia.

PRAYING FOR OUR NEIGHBORS



We are PRAYING people. One of our goals is to pray for every home/family in Rome and Floyd County. We are asking every pastor, every church, every member to pray for their neighbors. The online tool we are using to accomplish this is called **"Bless Every Home"**. Below is a simple step-by-step process to guide you through signing up and to begin praying for 5 of your neighbors every day.

- 1 - Go to <https://blesseveryhome.com/> and click on the sign up tab.
- 2 - Create an account (you will not pay for anything, this is FREE) by answering the questions. You will need to provide a current/active email address (because this is how you will receive your daily reminder to pray for 5 of your neighbors).
- 3 - Once you have created an account, you will have a "dashboard". It is on this dashboard that you can adjust the settings on the areas that you want to pray for and the number of neighbors.
- 4 - Every day you will get an email with the names and addresses of your 5 neighbors to pray for with a different scripture to pray for them. Once you have prayed for them, simply click on the "prayed" tab.
- 5 - You may even want to use this as a guide as you prayer walk your neighborhood, or write a short note to your neighbors introducing yourself and let them know you are praying for them.

"Come, follow me and I will send you out to fish for people." ~Matthew 4:19

Day One: Sunday, October 16, 2022

PRAY TODAY for... your personal spiritual health. Pray that God would draw you closer to Himself and that you would have the eyes of your heart enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which He has called you (Ephesians 1:18). Confess your sin and praise God for His mercy and grace.

Day Two: Monday, October 17, 2022

PRAY TODAY for... the spiritual health of those in your circle (your family, friends, neighbors, and coworkers). Pray that God would use you to proclaim His excellence to the nations (1 Peter 2:9).




