DLIFE

Pastor & life Ministerial Staff

Last year we had a great discipleship group for pastors/staff members and a new group will begin in a few weeks. Based on reports, there were 40+ new discipleship groups started as a result of last year's dLife efforts. We still have a few open spots in this new group, so please contact the FCBA office ASAP to claim your spot! In this group (usually 8-12 pastors/staff members) we

encourage each other, discuss the Bible, and pray for one another. The goal of this group is for the participant pastors to multiply and begin a group in their church. In this 13 week process, we will use the dLife Legacy and Leadership Track through which we will disciple one another and be introduced to a simple, biblical, and reproducible disciple-making process. Topics will include: The Disciple-Making Leader; The Praying Leader; The Missional Leader; The Servant Leader; The Teaching Leader; The Accountable Leader; The Persevering Leader; The Humble Leader; The Spirit-Filled Leader; The Family Leader; The Multiplying Leader; The Multigenerational Leader; and the Biblical Leader.

The material is easy to use. Every day you will have one Bible chapter to read and write a quick response. The group will gather weekly and we will discuss one of the readings from the week. Each week someone in the group will lead the prayer time, paraphrase the scripture, read the passage, and lead the discussion time. This is a proven and effective way to begin a disciple making strategy in your church.

There is no cost involved; yes - FREE! We will meet weekly at the FCBA office at 8 a.m. on Tuesday mornings. This will be a rewarding experience and it will connect you with some other awesome ministers/leaders in our area. GBC EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE UPDATE

The last Executive Committee of the Georgia Baptist Convention/Mission Board was held on December 13, 2022 in Warner Robins. I attended as the representative of the Floyd County Baptist Association. Below is a summary of that meeting:

<u>The Georgia Baptist Children's Home report was given by Kenny Thompson:</u> They are celebrating 150 years of ministry which began with the first home in Atlanta; currently there are 6 locations in Georgia with homes. In 2023 they will restart Camp Hawkins for children with developmental disabilities. They are expanding their ministries to homeless mothers and their children. Kenny Thompson is retiring January 28, 2023; Dr. Brian Hawkins will be the new CEO. He has 23 years of experience working with the GBCH.

<u>Georgia Baptist Retirement Communities:</u> Sharon Watson, the CEO, shared a video with testimonies from the residents. Some of the residents have started a ministry to serve homeless veterans.

<u>Truett McConnell University report was given by Emer Canter:</u> The Charles Stanley Chair of Theology Scholarship is given to train students for vocational ministry. A new police academy was started at TMU to train police officers as well as train police chaplains.

<u>Georgia Baptist Village report was given by Eric Mathison:</u> They provide independent-living, personal care and skilled nursing care. They have over 400 senior adults living at the Village. They have had a very difficult time recovering from COVID. It may be toward the end of 2024 before they experience a full recovery. They are at 75% occupancy because of the difficulty of hiring a full staff of caregivers. It should also be noted that they have provided over \$1.2 million in benevolent care in the last three years.

The Administration Committee report was given by Matt Peek: Resolutions were passed at the 3/16/21 and 12/14/21 Executive Committee meetings to give permission to GBMB executive staff to pursue a possible 99-year land lease agreement for development of current BCM properties. This would be with the Covenant Capital Investors. The agreement would be a 99-year land/property lease in which the GBMB would continue to own the land currently occupied by the BCM Centers. Covenant Capital Investors would raze the current BCM buildings on each property agreed upon to replace them with new buildings. The new buildings will include student housing, attractional space (such as a coffee shop, a sandwich shop, etc.), and designated space for the BCM Centers. Covenant Capital Investors is interested in working on 5 campuses at this time: UGA, Georgia Tech, Georgia State, West Georgia, and Georgia Southern.

Thomas Hammond the GBMB Executive Director reported: The 2023 GBC Annual meeting will be held November 13-14 at the Church on Main in Snellville, Georgia. The GBMB Mission & Ministry on Sugarloaf Parkway has a lease/purchase contract with a potential buyer. The sale price will be approximately \$30 million with a five year lease with a purchase option. The GBMB employees have started moving out of the offices. The temporary small office is Suwanee on Brogdon Exchange and other employees will be located in a church while others will be working remotely. The lease of the Georgia Baptist Missions and Ministry Center (with option to purchase) begins February 1, 2023. It is a five year lease with an option to extend the lease another five years. The GBMB is under a strict confidentiality agreement with the potential tenant until the lease is signed. The GBMB is moving out of the property no later than January 23, 2023. It should be noted that more than half of the current staff live and work in other areas of the state. The Cooperative Program (missions giving and offerings from GB churches) is trending down as compared to 2021 giving. It is projected to be a decline of over 10% from 2021 and this trend is a national trend not just a Georgia issue. However, the GBMB continues to operate in the black due to disciplined spending. The new Chairman of the Executive Committee is David Mills and the Vice Chairman is Steven Fountain. If you have further questions about the GBMB please don't hesitate to contact me.

CHURCH AND COMMUNITY MISSIONS SPOTLIGHT

What an exciting time we have been having these past few months.

In October we were honored to minister to the Coosa Valley Fair workers. We served 200 BBQ plates, held English & Spanish worship services and they were given a Bible and hygiene bag. 19 Backpacks of Love were delivered to the Department of Family and Children Services. The food pantry served 161 clients and gave out 10,465 pounds of food.

In November we took toy store applications. On November 16th some students from Armuchee High School's National Honor Society came and set up the auditorium in preparation for the Toy Store. They also unpacked toys that were in storage from the previous year and sorted out/set up the toys by age and gender groups. These students were treated to pizza and dessert for the terrific work they did! On November 21st, 14 of "Cindy's Elves" were treated to breakfast at Landmark Restaurant and then headed to the East Rome Walmart for some serious shopping! A special thank you to Bush Arbor for the use of their bus and their driver Cindy Young. We were again, richly blessed by some students from Armuchee High School's National Honor Society who came and helped unload the toys from the bus. On November 22nd a volunteer breakfast was held at the Landmark restaurant. We appreciate our volunteers so much—the ministry center could not function without them. On November 29th 80 Bibles and 50 hygiene bags were given to Eve Sheffield who ministered to residents at 5th Avenue, Chulio and Pruitt Nursing Homes. This is a great mission project for people who sometimes are forgotten at Christmas time. We served 242 clients in the food pantry and gave out 15,730 pounds of food.

In December we were blessed to help 140 children (55 families) through the Christmas Toy Store - the most ever! Each child received 3 new toys, a stocking and a gift card from Chick-Fil-A. This year, through a generous donation, each family served was given a ham for Christmas dinner—what a blessing! We served 164 clients in our food pantry and gave out 10,660 pounds of food.

<u>COMING MARCH 20-25, 2023</u> Georgia Baptist Mobile Dental Clinic 6pm - 9pm Monday-Friday/ 9am - noon on Saturday. This service is for Floyd County residents without dental insurance. The following volunteers are needed: dentists, oral surgeons, nurses, people to witness, people to just sit and comfort the clients waiting. This is a huge undertaking and we need your help! 
