Invitation to Participate as Interview Partner in a Student Research Project on EU HTA

As part of the Master's program in "Health Science – Prevention, Promotion" at Technical University of Munich, a project course will be conducted in cooperation with **Daiichi Sankyo** during the winter semester.

Student teams will work on a **real-world project** addressing current challenges in **European Health Technology Assessment (EU HTA)**. The project will examine **initial experiences with the first Joint Clinical Assessments (JCAs)** conducted under the new EU HTA Regulation.

Since a literature search is not sufficient to answer the research question, students should be given the opportunity to interview stakeholders in the EU HTA process. To complement the literature review, students will conduct **qualitative interviews** with stakeholders involved in or affected by the EU HTA process.

We are seeking **experts and stakeholders** willing to share their insights on:

- The implementation of EU HTA and JCAs,
- Challenges and opportunities encountered,
- Implications for national HTA processes.

Interviews will be conducted online or in person between November 2025 and January 2026. All information will be treated confidentially and used solely for academic purposes. The interview results will inform the students' final project reports, which will also be shared with Daiichi Sankyo as part of the course collaboration. As this is a student project, we regret that no financial compensation can be offered.
