


Rev. Dr. Steve Dodson will speak at our GIC Kickoff Dinner on Friday, February 27.



Steve Dodson is currently the senior pastor at Thomson First Methodist Church in Thomson, GA. He is a fourth-generation Methodist preacher and has led churches in various communities across North Georgia and in Tennessee.

Steve is a graduate of Wofford College in Spartanburg, SC where he earned honors as the outstanding graduate in the Department of Religion. He furthered his education by earning the Master of Divinity degree from the Candler School of Theology at Emory University. Later, Steve earned the Doctor of Ministry degree from Asbury Theological Seminary in Kentucky.

In his three decades of ministry, Steve has developed a reputation as a vibrant Biblical preacher and a strategic visionary leader. He has contributed to Homiletics (a journal for pastors), written and filmed a video Bible study series (by Bristol Books) and participated in a pilot project of Christian to the Core.

As a mission-minded pastor, Steve has served on the Board of TMS-Global (formerly The Mission Society), traveled on preaching/teaching missions to multiple nations in Asia, Africa, Central America and Australia, and facilitated the formation of an urban Christian Academy.

Steve is married to Susan (40 years this June), is the father of one daughter, Liz, and proud grandfather of two grandsons (Karson, age 12 and Walker, age 8).

Joy currently serves as president of **Operation Beautiful Feet**. The ministry is named from scripture, Romans 10:15—"How beautiful are the feet of those who bring the Good News of the Gospel."

Joy has preached and taught in more than 80 nations across Africa, Asia, Europe, Latin America, the Middle East and the USA. Key areas of emphasis include intimacy with God through the sanctifying power of the Holy Spirit, Biblical leadership, discipleship and missions.

Joy attended Asbury Theological Seminary, graduating with a Masters of Divinity degree. She is a Connectional Elder of the North Georgia Global Methodist Church, and also serves on the boards of Indian Springs Holiness Campmeeting and the Francis Asbury Society.
