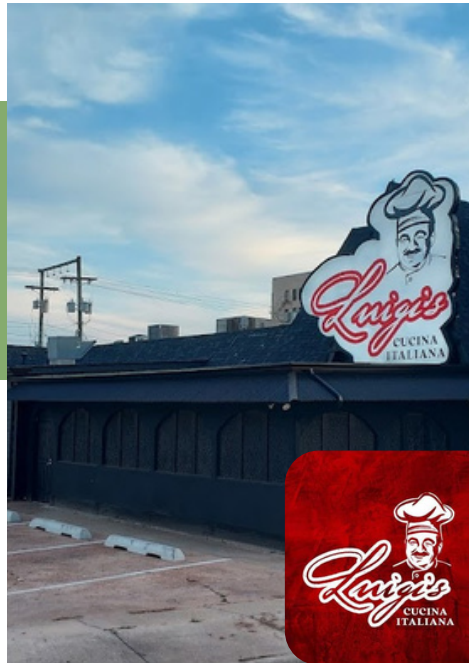




Local Flavor: Chickasha's Favorite Dining Spots
