A good task / penance for the coming season of Lent! Wednesday is Ash Wednesday! See you in church? Lent begins!

EUCHARISTIC ADORATION: Immediately following 9:30am



Mass on the Sundays of Lent, till 3:00pm, the "Blessed Sacrament" is publicly exposed on the High Altar. It is an opportunity for all to spend time before Jesus in prayer. There must be at least two adults present in the church at all times. Come and pray for vocations, healing, peace

or intentions of your own. Sign-up sheets, with times, are at all entrances of church. Consider committing to a time slot.

LENTEN REGULATIONS: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59.

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards. If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS: will be held all Fridays during Lent



beginning Fri., Feb. 16th at 7:00pm in church. This is a wonderful way to introduce our young people to a time-honored Catholic tradition. Please bring them. It is also an appropriate devotion for non-Catholic Christians. All are welcome. The service

lasts about 25 minutes. Enter through the parking lot (south) door.
