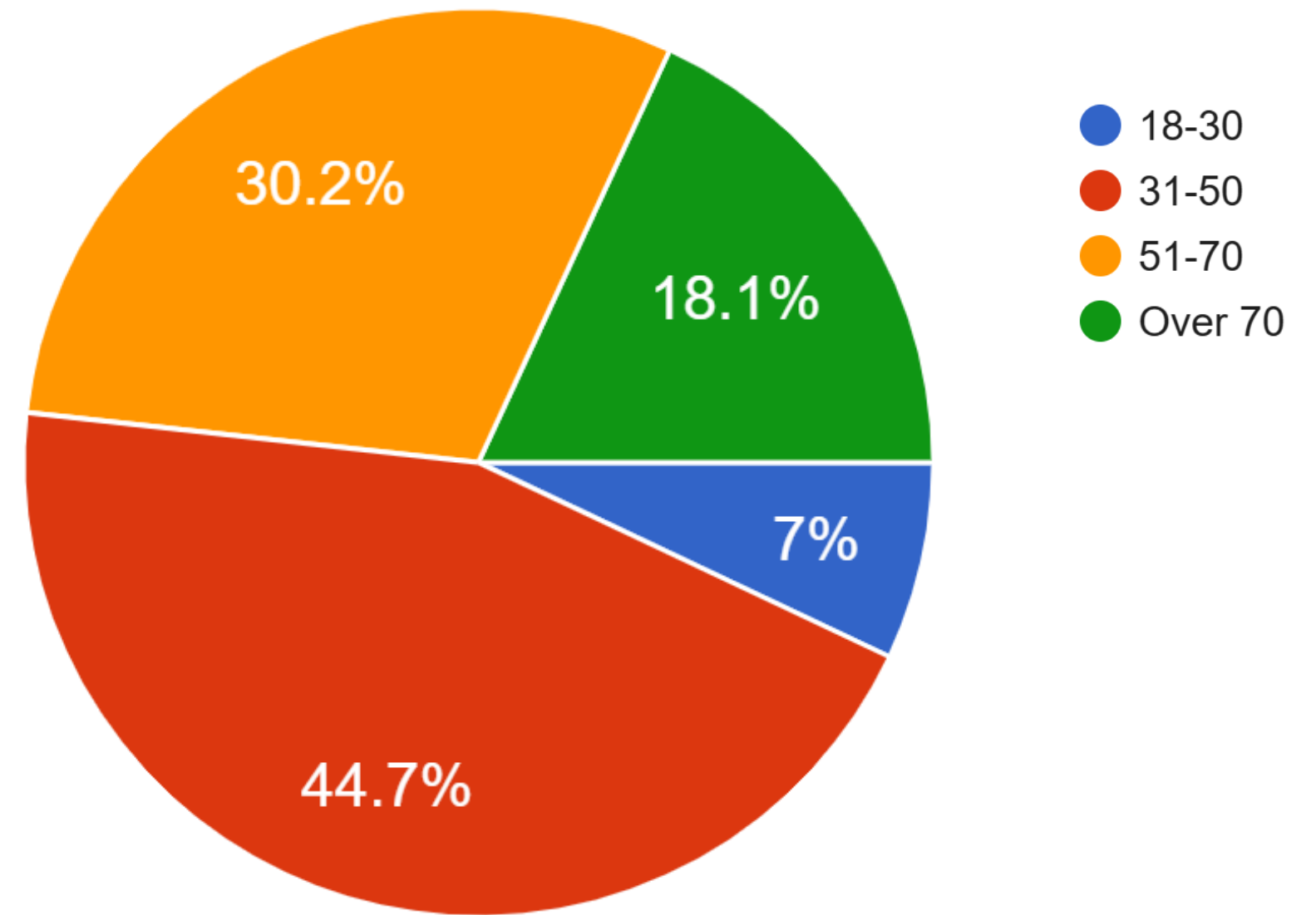

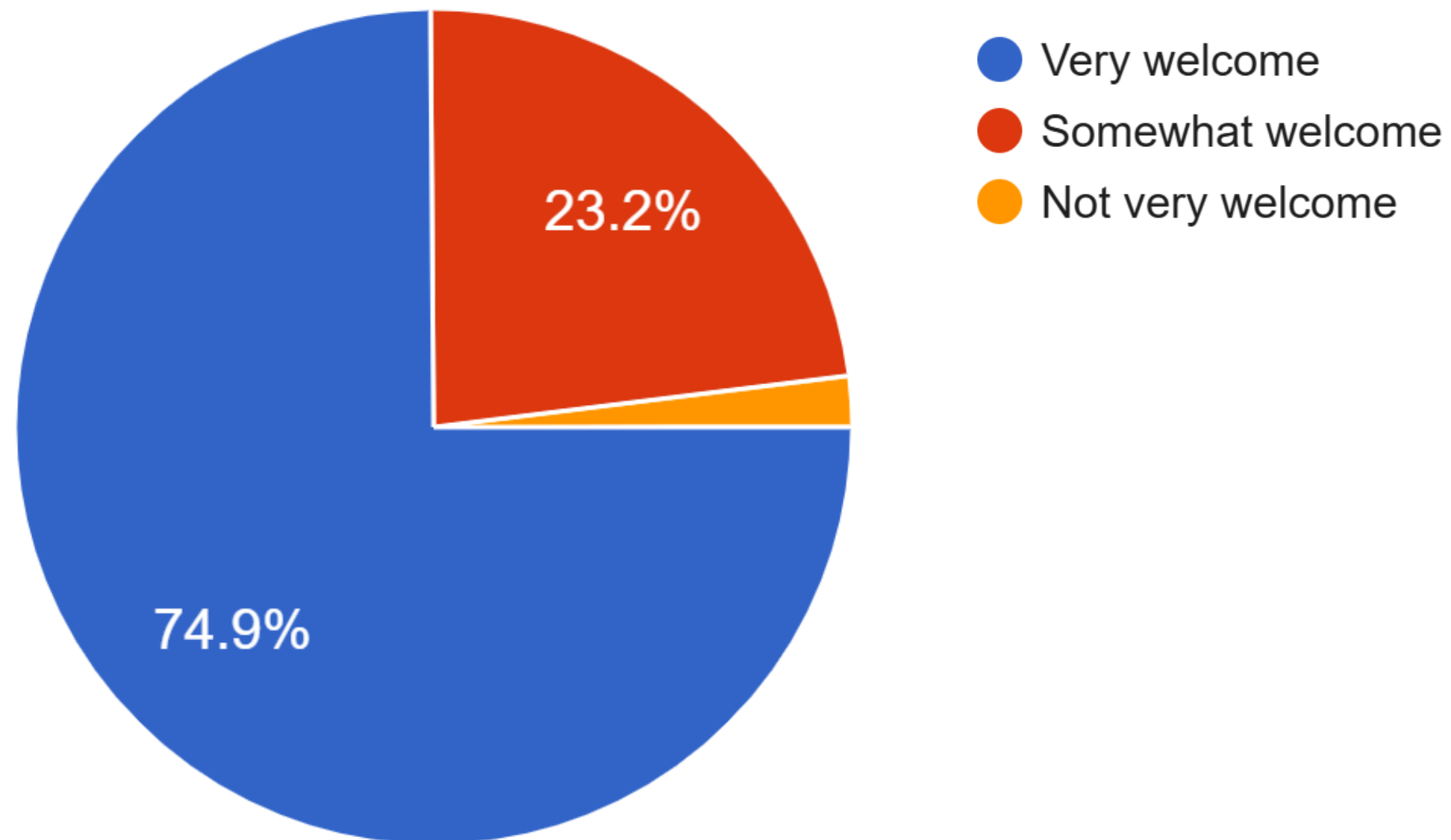

How welcome and included do you feel in our parish community?

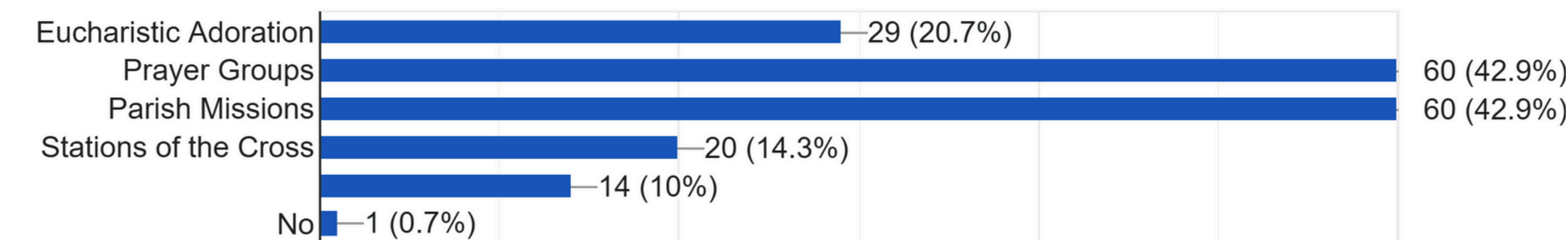

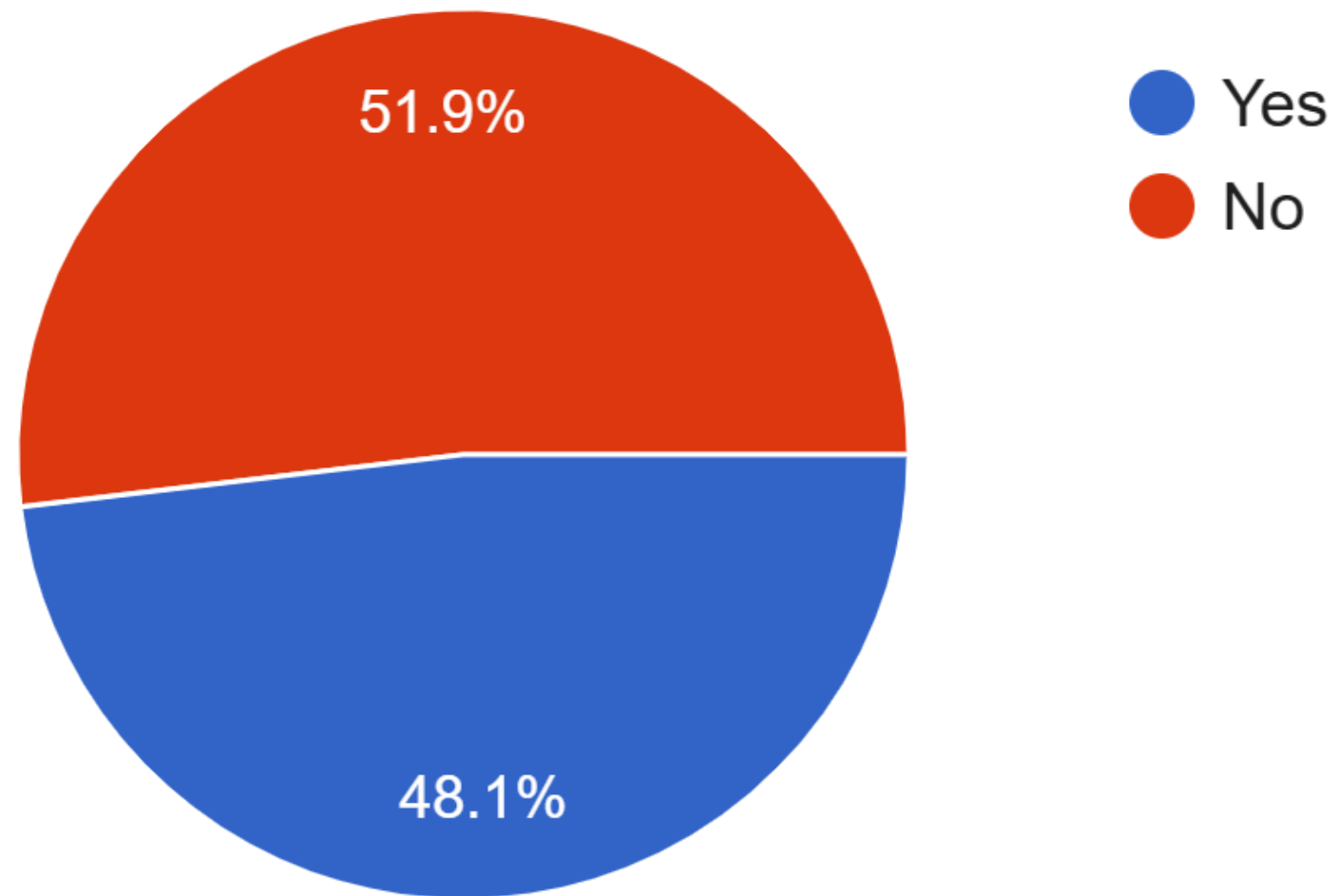

Are you interested in participating in parish ministry?

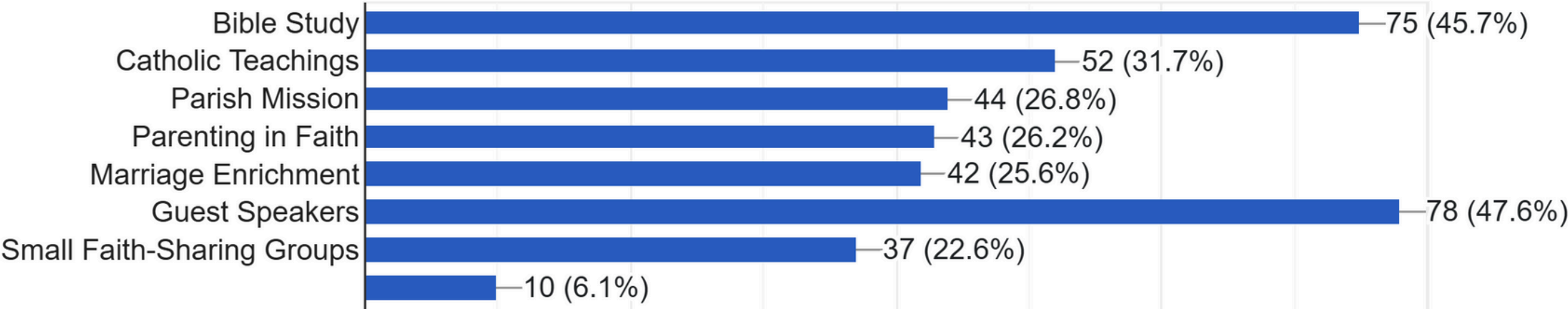

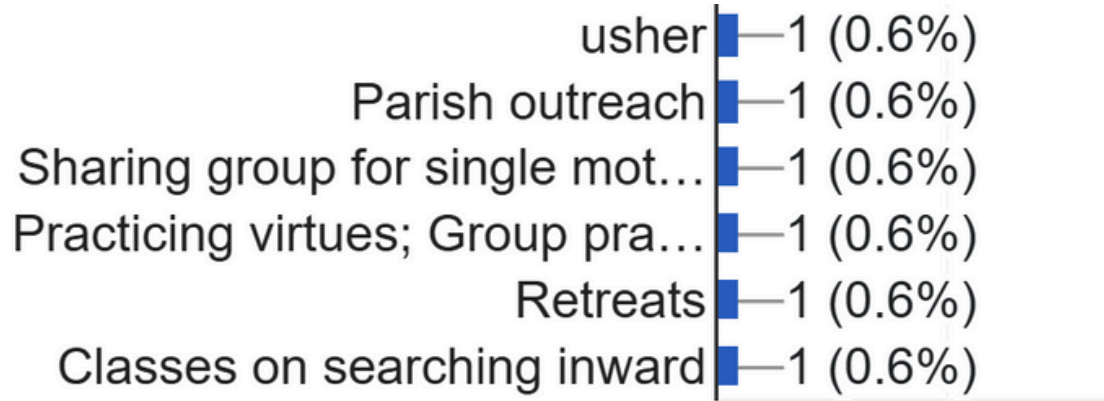

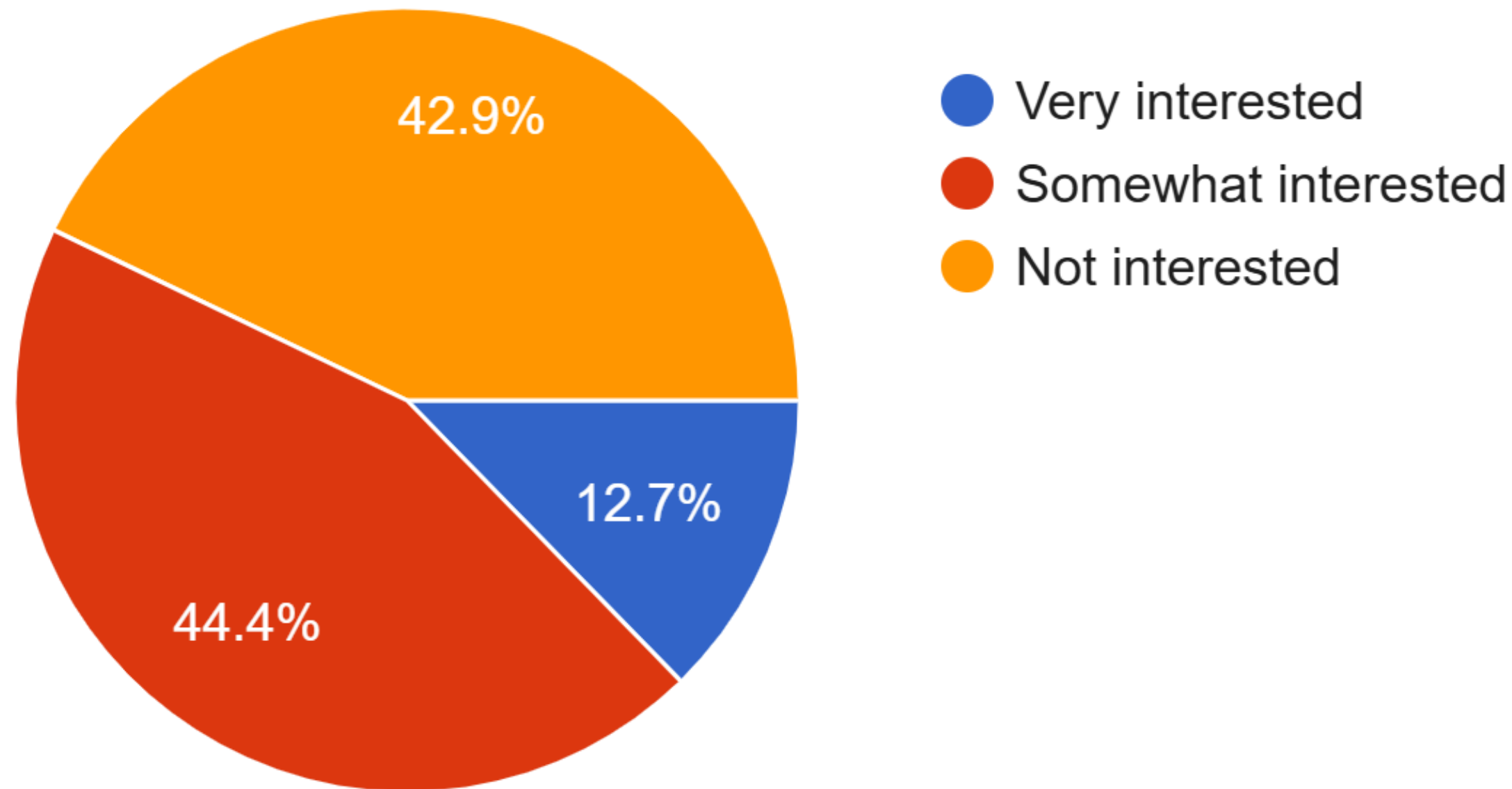

How interested are you in parish retreats or days of reflection?

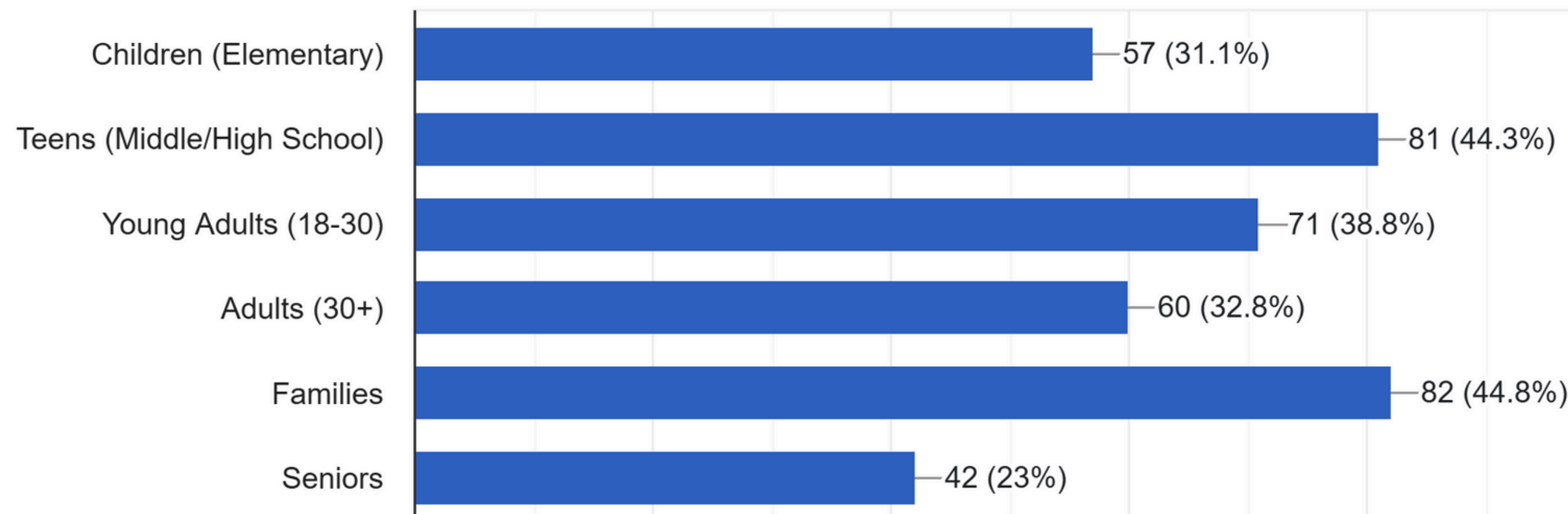

Which age group would you like to see more programs for?

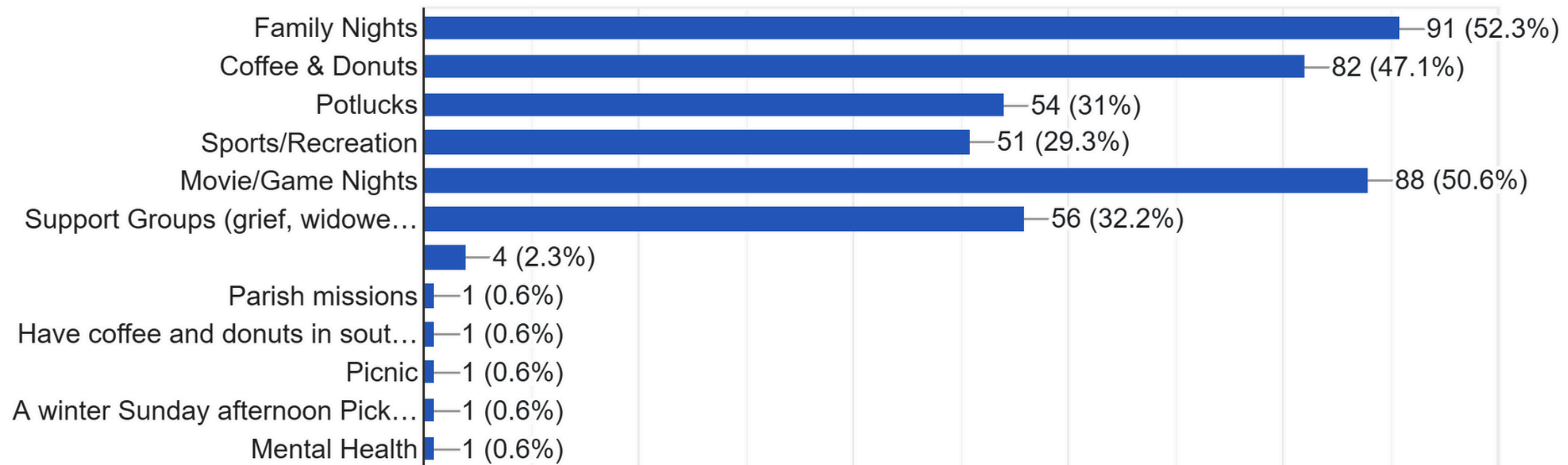

What type of parish events would you enjoy?

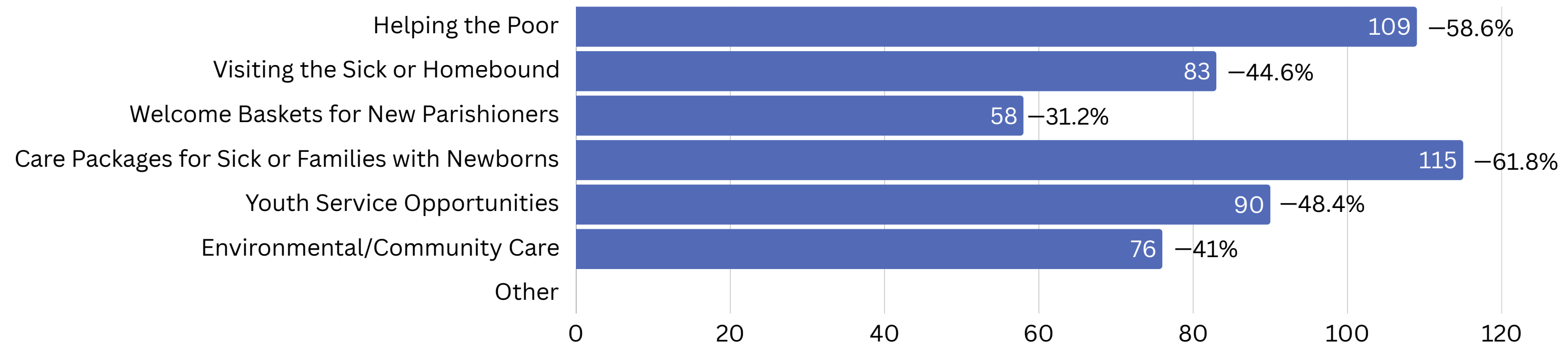

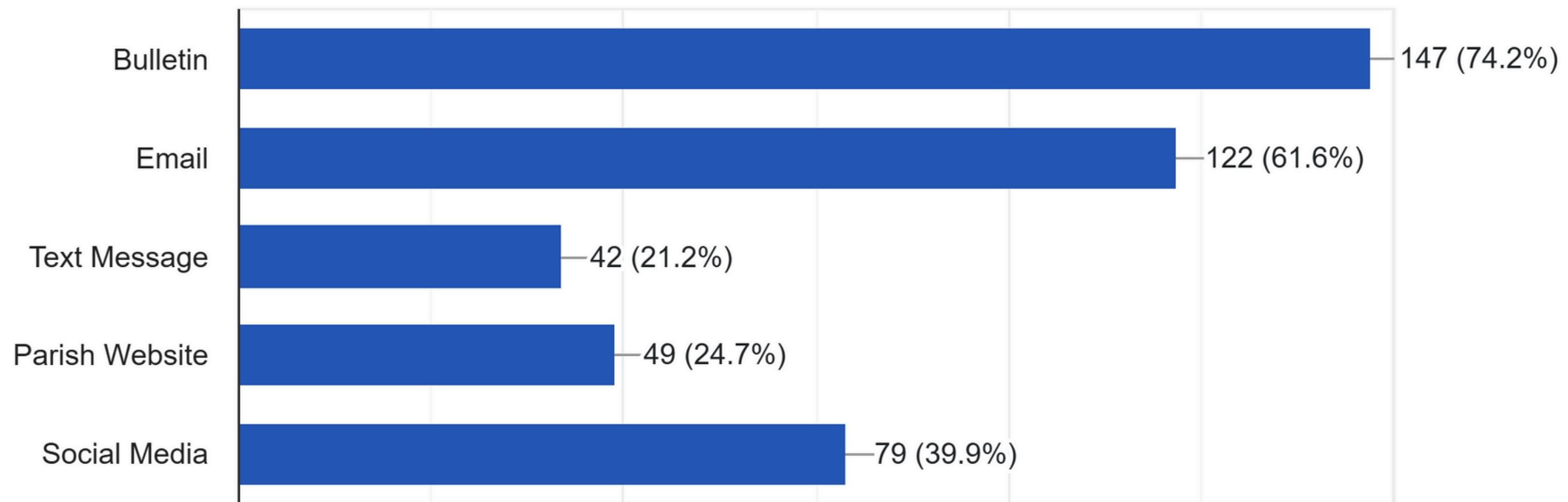
