SERMON Rev. Dr. Nancy Holt Timothy
“God’s View of Who You Are”

Text: Matthew 5:13-14 “You are the salt of the earth; You are the light of the world.”

- I. What will the future hold...?
 - a. Self-fulfilling prophecies
 - b. What we tell ourselves (and are told) matters
- II. Matthew 5:13-14
 - a. Jesus is very clear how God feels about us
 - b. We are salt of the earth
 - c. Salt is valued – Latin root for salary
 - d. “Nothing more useful than sun and salt”
- III. “You are the light of the World” – work to do!
 - a. We are called to be givers, not takers
 - b. Light directs and reflects and guides and helps
- IV. Has been called “A Kiss and A Commandment”
 - a. Kiss – God’s love and care and grace
 - b. Commandment: Do the right thing – serve!
 - c. Some put stress on one and ignore the other

V. d. Jesus says – and shows – BOTH!!
We need the whole picture
a. Jesus says “You are beloved salt”
b. Jesus says “Light up the world”
c. That’s God view of and for us!!
