Squamish Funeral Chapel Ltd. has been meeting the needs of the Sea to Sky Corridor with its Family Owned & Full Service Funeral Home since 1967.

Our family, The McKenzie Family, has been in the funeral profession for three generations. The first generation funeral directors of our family, Don & Jessie McKenzie, started in the funeral profession in 1946 by working at local funeral homes in Vancouver & West Vancouver.

Their son, George McKenzie (2nd Generation Funeral Director), started working with his parents at their funeral home at the age of 14 answering phones and helping his parents on services at Hollyburn Funeral Home in West Vancouver.

George went on to BCIT where he received his Diploma & License as a Funeral Director & Embalmer in 1982. During his studies he received the "Professionalism Award" for his class year.

In 1988, George & his wife, Mildred McKenzie, bought Squamish Funeral Chapel & installed their own Crematorium to service the Sea to Sky Corridor.

George & Mildred have brought their own special personalized service to the corridor. They believe a funeral is similar to other ceremonies in our lives; such as a graduation ceremony, a wedding, or a baptism, a funeral is a rite of passage by which we recognize an important event that distinguishes our lives.

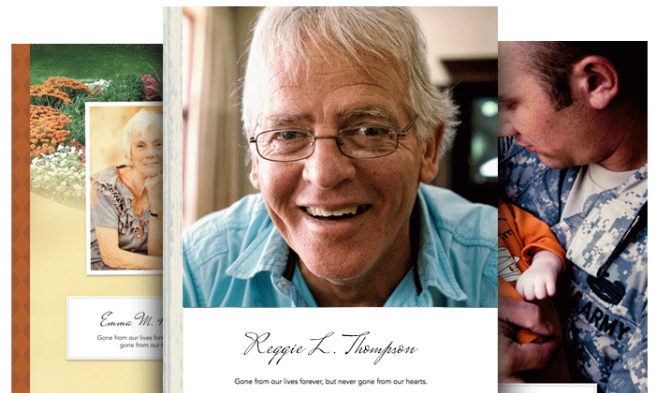
