2026 ARBOR DAY POSTER RULES AND ENTRY FORM

“TREES ARE TERRIFIC IN CITIES AND TOWN”

Rules:

1. Must use theme “TREES ARE TERRIFIC IN CITIES AND TOWNS” (Doesn't need to be written but incorporated in the artwork).
2. Must be original work.
3. Must not contain cartoons or characters from TV, books, movies, or sports figures
4. Poster must be accompanied by a signed application form.
5. Posters must be 11x17. Paper available at City Hall
6. Must be done in one of the following mediums, marker, crayon, colored pencil, watercolor, ink, finger paint, chalk, or pen. Poster must be reproducible and NOT a collage (nothing can be glued or taped to the poster)
7. Posters must be flat. Folded, mounted, framed or laminated are not acceptable.
8. Submitter must be a resident of Ferron.

Submitted posters will be divided into the following age groups for judging.

- 0-4-year-olds
- 5-7-year-olds
- 8-10-year-olds
- 11-13-year-olds
- 14-18-year-olds

1st place posters will be on display for one year in City Hall and may be used for advertisements for Arbor Day 2027
