RISE (Readiness, Improvement, Success, Empowerment) is Utah's multistage computer adaptive assessment system that includes tests for English Language Arts (ELA), Mathematics, Science and Writing. Our students in grades 3-5 will be participating in these evaluations these next two weeks. We begin testing at 8:30 am. As the testing period begins, please limit student tardiness and absences.
