STUDENT DROP-OFF & PICK-UP

It is our priority to keep students safe during drop-off and pickup before and after school. Here are a few reminders of our policy:

- *All non-bus riding students need to enter and exit through the front doors of the school.
- *All vehicles **MUST PARK** along the curbside to allow students to get in and out of their vehicle.
- *Students must enter on the passenger side of the vehicle in order to avoid crossing in front of the travel lane.
- *Students must remain on the sidewalk at all times.
- *Students are not allowed to cross the drive-thru crosswalk without an adult escort.

Please be patient as everyone falls into a routine for the school year. Pickup generally lasts less than 5 minutes.
