Role Purpose

Prepare and file simple tax returns for low-income individuals, ensuring accuracy and timeliness.

Key Responsibilities

- Use CRA-provided software (U-File) to prepare and file basic tax returns.
- Communicate with staff about any issues or missing information related to tax preparation.
- Return completed tax packages within one week of receiving them.
- Note: We only file taxes for low-income individuals with simple tax returns (no business or self-employment income).

Qualifications

- Strong attention to detail.
- Comfortable learning and using basic tax preparation software.
- Ability to work independently and meet deadlines.
- Awareness of confidentiality and data privacy standards.
- Must have access to a computer or laptop (unfortunately, the software is not compatible with Mac's).
- Must pass CRA screening and eligibility.

Time Commitment

- Flexible, self-directed scheduling during tax season (February – April).

Training Provided

- A brief orientation of United Way's workflow for the program.
- Access to CRA provided "how-to" training videos for specific tax scenarios.
