Building Strong Communities

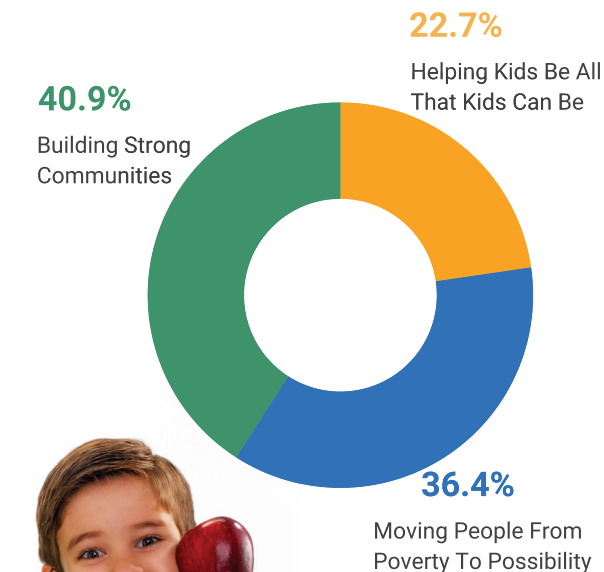
