

Advent comes from the Latin *adventus*, meaning "coming" or "arrival." It is a four-week season of preparation for the birth of Jesus Christ and a reminder of His promised return.

It is not just a countdown to Christmas but a time of reflection, prayer, and expectation. Themes include **hope, peace, joy, and love**.

The Advent Wreath



- Symbolism: The Advent wreath is a circle of evergreen branches, representing eternity and everlasting life in Christ.
- Candles: Four candles (sometimes five, with a central "Christ candle") are lit progressively each week, symbolizing the growing light of Christ in a dark world. And each candle represents the different Advent Themes of hope, peace, joy, and love.
