



## PARKING INFORMATION

---

### **DOWNTOWN PARKING**

---

Residents of any of the downtown properties can lease a parking space in the downtown parking garages. These garages are managed by the City of Bloomington and Olympus does not have any control over the price. Price is subject to change at any time.

When moving out at the end of the lease term, it is the responsibility of the resident to cancel the parking permit.

### **ON STREET PARKING**

---

Neighborhood parking permits are available from the City of Bloomington's Parking Enforcement Department.

Residents qualifying for neighborhood parking and visitor permits may obtain permits by visiting <https://bloomington.in.gov/transportation/parking/neighborhood-parking>. ### **OLYMPUS LOT PARKING**

---

If you are parking in an Olympus managed lot, residents will receive a parking permit upon move in. Display your parking permit on your rearview mirror.

### **PARKING AT COLLEGE PARK APARTMENTS**

---

Olympus will issue parking permits from Tempo Properties to College Park residents. A maximum of 2 permits are issued per unit.
