Grapes, vines and vineyards are mentioned throughout the

Bible. Noah planted the first vineyard, following the flood. Giant clusters of grapes, were a symbol of the richness of the Promised Land:

23 “When they reached the Valley of Eshkol, they cut off a branch, bearing a single cluster of grapes two of them carried it on a pole between them...

24 That place was called the Valley of Eshkol because of the cluster of grapes the Israelites cut off there.” Numbers 13:23-24 NIV

“For every tree is known by its own fruit. For men do not gather grapes from a bramble bush.” Luke 6:44 NKJV

Jesus referred to grapes in His teaching.

“Just as a tree is known by its own fruits,” people often reveal what is in their hearts, through actions and speech.
