America the Beautiful

"O beautiful for spacious skies
For amber waves of grain,

The patriotic, God including stanzas of America the Beautiful, by Katherine Lee Bates, were first written in poem form in 1893. K.L. Bates, during a journey to the western US, was motivated to write, upon seeing "beautiful," mountainous scenery. Travel brought her to the top of Pikes Peak, Colorado in a covered wagon and inspired writing the words to America the Beautiful. Psalm 33:12 assures us: "Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord..." Bates' original poem was revised and put to music. The song is sometimes referred to as an "unofficial national anthem-" second to the Star Spangled Banner. "On a clear day, atop the Colorado Rocky Mountains, you may catch a glimpse of: New Mexico, Nebraska, Kansas, Wyoming and Oklahoma, depending on conditions." Source: Instagram
