Harry D. Clarke. Clarke was orphaned
at a young age in Wales, United Kingdom,
ran away from an orphanage, moved to
London, and worked at sea for nearly
10 years. Clarke, with help from an older
brother, came to the USA, where
he attended Moody Bible Institute
in Chicago. He became an evangelist with
a musical publishing career.

Like Simon (Peter) and Andrew,
who were called upon by Jesus to become
fishers of men for the Kingdom of
God, so God continues to call upon
His followers today.
