Who are we?

When we talk about "Premier Washers", or "us" or "we" in this notice, we are talking about Premier Washers Limited (Company Registration - .4759535). We share your information within Premier Washers to help us provide our services, comply with regulatory and legal requirements, and improve our products.

Data Protection Officer

Our Data Protection Officer oversees how we collect, use, share and protect your information to ensure your rights are fulfilled. How we collect information about you

We collect personal information from you, for example when you contact us with

- Details of orders or quotations
- When you ask for advice
- When you provide product specifications
- When you provide bank details to make or receive payments

How we keep your information safe

We protect your information with security measures under the laws that apply and we meet international standards. We keep our computers, files and buildings secure. When you contact us to ask about your information, we may ask you to identify yourself. This is to help protect your information.

How long we keep your information

To meet our legal and regulatory obligations, we hold your information while you are a customer and for a period of time after that. We do not hold it for longer than necessary.

Meeting our legal and regulatory obligations

To use your information lawfully, we rely on one or more of the following legal bases:

- performance of a contract;
- legal obligation;
- protecting the vital interests of you or others;
- public interest;
- our legitimate interests; and
- your consent.

To meet our regulatory and legal obligations, we collect some of your personal information, verify it, and delete it once we no longer have to keep it.

Consent

Sometimes we need your consent to use your personal information. With direct marketing for example, we need your consent to make you aware of products and services which may be of interest to you. If we ever contact you to get your feedback on ways to improve our products and services, you have the choice to opt out. You can remove your consent at any time by contacting us.

How we use your information

We use information about you to:

- provide relevant products and services:
- identify ways we can improve our products and services;
- maintain and monitor your products and services;
- protect both our interests;
- · meet our legal and regulatory obligations; and
- decide and recommend how our products and services might be suitable for you.

To provide our products and services under the terms and conditions we agree between us, we need to collect and use personal information about you. If you do not provide this personal information, we may not be able to provide you with our products and services. We analyze the information we collect on you through your use of our products and services. This helps us understand your requirements, how we interact with you and provide you with consistent, quality products.

Your information and third parties

Sometimes we share your information with our subcontractors. For instance finishers or carriers. These third party businesses will never receive your phone number or email address unless you have given prior consent. .

We expect these third parties to have the same levels of information protection that we have. When we believe we have been given false or misleading information, or we suspect criminal activity we must record this and tell law enforcement agencies.
