

STEWARSHIP REFLECTION — The Baptism of Our Lord

"John tried to prevent him, saying, "I need to be baptized by you, yet you are coming to me?" MATTHEW 3:14

January 10 - 11 The Baptism of the Lord

HOLY WATER — As we celebrate The Baptism of the Lord this weekend, the ending of the Christmas season and the beginning of Jesus' public ministry, we remind you that you may obtain holy water at church for your use at home. The container of holy water is in the side door vestibule of the church. Just bring a small jar or bottle and fill it up from the spigot on the holy water container.

The Five Luminous Mysteries:

1. **The Baptism in the Jordan:** Jesus' baptism by John the Baptist, where the heavens opened and the Father's voice proclaimed Him as His Son.
2. **The Wedding at Cana:** Jesus' first public miracle, turning water into wine at a wedding feast, revealing His glory.
3. **The Proclamation of the Kingdom of God:** Jesus' public preaching, calling for conversion and announcing the coming of God's Kingdom.
4. **The Transfiguration:** Jesus' appearance dramatically changed on the mountain before Peter, James, and John, revealing His divine glory.
5. **The Institution of the Eucharist:** Jesus giving His Body and Blood as food at the Last Supper, offering Himself for humanity's salvation.
